A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
SAN DIEGO APPROVING THE REIMBURSEMENT
AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AND
THE CITY OF LA MESA FOR CERTAIN IMPROVEMENTS
INCLUDED IN THE MONTEZUMA/MID-CITY PIPELINE
PHASE 2 PROJECT AND RELATED ACTIONS.

RECITALS

The Council of the City of San Diego (Council) adopts this Resolution based on the following:

A. The City of San Diego's (City) Montezuma/Mid-City Pipeline Phase 2 project (Project) consists of installing a 66-inch diameter water transmission line from Alvarado Water Treatment Plant (AWTP) to the intersection of 69th Street and Mohawk Street. A portion of the Project work falls within the City of La Mesa (La Mesa).

B. It was determined that a portion of La Mesa's 8-inch concrete sewer main that runs parallel to the City's proposed 66-inch pipe installation would be impacted by the Project. In addition, it was determined that the existing roadway along 70th Street and Lake Murray Boulevard would be impacted by the Project's construction traffic control phasing and heavy construction equipment.

C. As a result, the City and La Mesa developed a cost-sharing reimbursement plan, requiring La Mesa to reimburse the City to replace portions of La Mesa's sewer main and perform certain road repair work (La Mesa Improvements) as part of the Project.

D. In January 2020, the City awarded a construction contract to James W. Fowler Company to construct the Project. On August 5, 2020, Council adopted Resolution R-313186, authorizing a reimbursement agreement between the City and La Mesa for construction of the

La Mesa Improvements, which is on file in the Office of the City Clerk as Document No. RR-313186 (2020 Reimbursement Agreement).

E. In February 2022, due to unforeseen Project delays, the construction contract between the City and James W. Fowler Company was terminated before the La Mesa Improvements were constructed.

F. In 2024, the City re-advertised and awarded a new construction contract to W. A. Rasic Construction Company, Inc. for the construction of the remaining Project work, including the La Mesa Improvements.

G. The City and La Mesa now desire to terminate the 2020 Reimbursement Agreement and enter into a new reimbursement agreement, under which La Mesa will reimburse the City \$283,135 for construction of the La Mesa Improvements (2025 Reimbursement Agreement). Execution of the 2025 Reimbursement Agreement will terminate the 2020 Reimbursement Agreement.

H. The Office of the City Attorney prepared this Resolution based on the information provided by City staff (including information provided by affected third parties and verified by City staff), with the understanding that this information is complete and accurate.

ACTION ITEMS

Be it resolved by the Council of the City of San Diego:

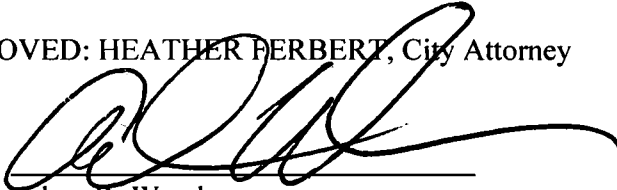
1. Council approves the 2025 Reimbursement Agreement.
2. The Mayor or designee is authorized to sign the 2025 Reimbursement Agreement on behalf of the City. Once signed by the Parties, the 2025 Reimbursement Agreement will be on file with the Office of the City Clerk as Document No. RR-316141.

3. The Mayor or designee is authorized to take necessary actions to secure funding from La Mesa under the 2025 Reimbursement Agreement.

4. The Chief Financial Officer is authorized to deposit funds into Fund 700011, Water Utility Fund, from La Mesa for the purpose of fulfilling the 2025 Reimbursement Agreement with La Mesa.
