

RESOLUTION NUMBER R- 316142DATE OF FINAL PASSAGE APR 22 2025

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO DETERMINING THAT THE CREATION AND FUNDING OF AN EMERGENCY CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT FOR THE REPLACEMENT AND REPAIRS TO THE MISSION BEACH LIFEGUARD STATION IS STATUTORILY EXEMPT FROM CEQA PURSUANT TO PUBLIC RESOURCES CODE SECTION 21080(B)(2) AND CEQA GUIDELINES SECTION 15269(B).

RECITALS

The Council of the City of San Diego (Council) adopts this Resolution based on the following:

A. The California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) (Public Resources Code section 21000 et seq.) states the CEQA Guidelines thereto (California Code of Regulations, Title 14, Chapter 3, Section 15000 et seq.) shall list those classes of projects which have been determined not to have a significant effect on the environment and which shall be exempt from CEQA.

B. Public Resources Code (Code) section 21084 requires the CEQA Guidelines to include a list of classes of projects that have been determined not to have a significant effect on the environment and are exempt from the provisions of CEQA. CEQA Guidelines sections 15260 through 15285 list the statutory CEQA exemptions promulgated by the California Legislature

C. The City of San Diego (City) Fire Rescue Department (SDFD) desires to create an emergency Capital Improvement Project (CIP) L-25001, Mission Beach Lifeguard Station, for emergency repairs to the SDFD Mission Beach Lifeguard Station (Project). The City desires Council action to allocate funding for a vendor to begin the process of assessing, designing, and

implementing the emergency repairs to the Mission Beach Lifeguard Station and/or a temporary facility.

D. The City's Planning Department has determined that the Project is statutorily exempt from CEQA pursuant to Public Resources Code Section 21080(b)(2) and CEQA Guidelines section 15269(b) (Emergency Projects).

E. Council has considered the potential environmental effect of the Project.

F. Council held a duly noticed public meeting and considered the written record for the Project as well as public comment.

G. Council, using its independent judgment, has determined that the Project is statutorily exempt from CEQA pursuant to Public Resources Code Section 21080(b)(2) and CEQA Guidelines section 15269(b) (Emergency Projects) which exempts emergency repairs to public service facilities necessary to maintain service essential to the public health, safety, or welfare. Emergency repairs include those that require a reasonable amount of planning to address an anticipated emergency.


