A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO APPROVING THE SETTLEMENT BETWEEN NOE CORDERO, ET AL. AND THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO

RECITALS

The Council of the City of San Diego (Council) adopts this Resolution based on the following:

- A. On June 17, 2022, Noe Cordero, and other current and former officers with the San Diego Police Department (SDPD) filed a lawsuit against the City of San Diego (City) titled *Noe Cordero, et al. v. City of San Diego*, United States District Court Case No. 3:23-CV-00365–LAB-JLB (Lawsuit). Plaintiffs are 21 current and former SDPD Police Officers assigned to Special Weapons and Tactics Unit Special Response Team (SRT) who allege the City failed to pay all specialty pay due SRT members required under collectively bargained Memoranda of Understanding (MOU) between the City and the San Diego Police Officer's Association (SDPOA). Plaintiffs further allege the City failed to account for this unpaid specialty pay when calculating overtime and pension contributions.
- B. At closed session on March 3, 2025, the City Council by the following votes: Yeas, Districts 1, 2, 3, 5, 6, 7, 8, and 9; Nays, District 4; and Absent, None, approved a settlement of Plaintiffs' claims for back pay, overtime, liquidated damages, interest, and legal fees and costs in the Lawsuit in the total amount of \$250,000. This settlement is made in conjunction with a separate resolution to approve an amendment to the operative MOU between the City and SDPOA to provide for additional specialty pay to members of SDPD's Special Response team. The settlement payment and agreement to amend the MOU are made in

exchange for a dismissal of the Lawsuit with prejudice, waiver of fees and costs, and release of claims against the City.

ACTION ITEMS

Be it resolved by the Council of the City of San Diego:

- 1. Authorizes the Mayor or his designee to pay the total sum of \$250,000.00 in settlement of each and every claim for unpaid compensation, interest, costs, and fees of any type, including attorneys' fees, against the City of San Diego, its agents and employees, arising from the Litigation.
- 2. Authorize the Chief Financial Officer to appropriate and expend an amount not to exceed \$48,750.00 from Public Liability Fund No. 720045 for the payment of attorneys' fees and costs for the purpose of settling the Litigation.
- 3. Authorize the Department of Finance and City to issue payroll checks in the total amount of \$201,250.00 to Plaintiffs individually from General Fund No. 100000 based on the allocation below and withhold employee taxes as well as employee contributions to the San Diego City Employees' Retirement System and interest thereon from payroll checks issued to those Plaintiffs who retired or entered the City's Deferred Retirement Option Program on or after June 17, 2018.
