A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT BETWEEN THE CITY AND MOST LIKELY TO, INC. FOR CONSULTING AND OUTREACH SERVICES FOR ORGANIC WASTE RECYCLING PROGRAMS AND ALL RELATED ACTIONS.

## **RECITALS**

The Council of the City of San Diego (Council) adopts this Resolution based on the following:

- A. California Senate Bill (SB) 1383, enacted in 2016, establishes methane gas production targets and requires California to reduce organic waste disposal in landfills and increase edible food recovery, among other measures; SB 1383 and its implementing regulations went into effect in January 2022.
- B. SB 1383 regulations require jurisdictions to, among other things, conduct education and outreach on organics recycling to residents, businesses, haulers, solid waste facilities, and food recovery organizations to ensure program success.
- C. The City received grant funds from the California Department of Resources

  Recycling and Recovery (CalRecycle) to assist with implementation of SB 1383 requirements,
  including education and outreach requirements (CalRecycle Grant).
- D. The City needs additional assistance to increase public awareness and participation in organics recycling programs, decrease contamination, and assist local businesses with edible food recovery.

- E. On November 8, 2024, the Environmental Services Department (ESD) issued Request for Proposals (RFP) # 10090180-25-R for Consulting and Outreach Services for Organic Waste Recycling Programs; the City accepted the proposal from Most Likely To, Inc (Contractor).
- F. The contract between City and Contractor will be in effect until April 1, 2026, for an amount not to exceed \$2,304,023, which will be funded entirely from CalRecycle Grant funds.
- G. The Environment Committee heard the item on April 17, 2025, and recommended approval.
- H. The Office of the City Attorney prepared this Resolution based on the information provided by City staff (including information provided by affected third parties and verified by City staff), with the understanding that this information is complete and accurate.

## **ACTION ITEMS**

Be it resolved by the Council of the City of San Diego:

1. That the Mayor, or his designee, is authorized to execute a contract with Most Likely To, Inc. for consulting and outreach services for organics waste recycling programs, to be in effect through April 1, 2026, in an amount not to exceed \$2,304,023, under the terms and conditions set forth in the contract on file in the office of the City Clerk as Document No.
