A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO DECLARING A CONTINUED STATE OF EMERGENCY REGARDING RAW SEWAGE, SOLID WASTE, AND SEDIMENT COMING FROM TIJUANA, MEXICO.

## **RECITALS**

The Council of the City of San Diego (Council) adopts this Resolution based on the following:

- A. California Government Code section 8630 authorizes local governing bodies to proclaim local emergencies when such events occur as are described in California Government Code section 8558(c).
- B. California Government Code section 8630 further provides that the local governing body review the need for continuing the local emergency at least once every 60 days until the governing body terminates the local emergency.
- C. The Council adopted San Diego Resolution R-282544 (Sept. 7, 1993), declaring the existence of a state of emergency regarding the escalated discharge of raw sewage across the international border into the City of San Diego (City) from Tijuana, Mexico.
- D. The Council adopted San Diego Resolution R-312652 (Sept. 10, 2019), declaring the existence of a state of emergency regarding solid waste and sediment flowing across the international border with Mexico via the Tijuana River and other waterways, into the City.
- E. Raw sewage, solid waste, and sediment flowing across the international border continues to pose the possibility of peril to persons and property in the City.
- F. The Office of the City Attorney prepared this Resolution based on the information provided by City staff with the understanding that this information is complete and accurate.

## **ACTION ITEMS**

Be it resolved by the Council of the City of San Diego:

- 1. Pursuant to California Government Code section 8630, a continued state of emergency is declared to persist due to raw sewage, solid waste, and sediment coming from Tijuana, Mexico.
