A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO ADOPTING AN AMENDED VERSION OF CITY OF SAN DIEGO COUNCIL POLICY 100-18, TITLED "COMMUNITY PARKING DISTRICT," ADOPTING AN AMENDED VERSION OF CITY OF SAN DIEGO COUNCIL POLICY 200-04, TITLED "INSTALLATION OR REMOVAL OF TIME LIMIT PARKING ZONES AND PARKING METER ZONES," AND ADOPTING AN AMENDED VERSION OF CITY OF SAN DIEGO COUNCIL POLICY 200-15, TITLED "VALET PARKING AND PASSENGER LOADING ZONE POLICY."

## **RECITALS**

The Council of the City of San Diego (Council) adopts this Resolution based on the following:

- A. In January 2025, a consulting firm retained by the City of San Diego (City) provided a citywide comprehensive Parking Demand Management Study that analyzed the City's current parking operations and offered recommendations for an efficient citywide parking management framework.
- B. The City seeks to implement the Parking Demand Management Study recommendations by revising City of San Diego Council Policies 100-18, titled "Community Parking District" (CP 100-18); Council Policy 200-04, titled "Installation or Removal of Time Limit Parking Zones and Parking Meter Zones" (CP 200-04); and Council Policy 200-15, titled "Valet Parking and Passenger Loading Zone Policy" (CP 200-15) as set forth in this Resolution.
- C. CP 100-18 was last updated on July 16, 2015 and describes the process for establishing Community Parking Districts and the rules to be followed by Community Parking District Advisory Boards when managing their districts and using parking meter funds.

- D. The proposed amendments to CP 100-18 include revising and clarifying the obligations of Community Parking District Advisory Boards in managing Community Parking Districts and updating policies on projects eligible for parking meter funds.
- E. CP 200-04 establishes the criteria for creating, managing and rescinding time limit and parking meter zones and was last updated on November 15, 2004.
- F. The proposed amendments to CP 200-04 include retitling the policy to "Management of Time Limit Parking Zones and Parking Meter Zones;" updating criteria for the installation and removal of zones; adding guidelines for parking studies and setting parking meter rates, including base rates, special event rates and dynamic pricing; and allowing residential parking permit programs where the City seeks to enforce parking meters in residential areas after 6:00 p.m. and on Sundays.
- G. CP 200-15 was adopted on March 5, 1984 and describes criteria to be used by the City for installation of passenger loading zones and valet parking zones. This policy has never been updated.
- H. The proposed amendments to CP 200-15 update the criteria and process to apply for permits for passenger loading and valet parking zones.
- I. The Office of the City Attorney prepared this Resolution based on the information provided by City staff including information provided by affected third parties and verified by City staff, with the understanding that this information is complete and accurate.
