RESOLUTION NUMBER R- 316241 DATE OF FINAL PASSAGE JUN 0 5 2025

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO APPROVING AN ADDITIONAL FISCAL YEAR 2025 ARTS, CULTURE, AND COMMUNITY FESTIVALS (ACCF) FUNDING ALLOCATION TO MEALS ON WHEELS SAN DIEGO FOR THE SENIOR ART WALK, PURSUANT TO COUNCIL POLICY 100-23, RECOMMENDED BY COUNCIL DISTRICT 6 AND RELATED ACTIONS.

RECITALS

The Council of the City of San Diego (Council) adopts this Resolution based on the following:

A. The Council adopted Council Policy 100-23, "City Council Funding of Arts, Culture and Community Festivals with Discretionary Transient Occupancy Tax Allocations," through Resolution R-307625 (Aug. 13, 2012). Council Policy 100-23 establishes uniform guidelines, conditions, and criteria governing the application for and granting of funds to nonprofit organizations to support their ongoing operational expenses and their sponsorship of special events. Annual funding levels are subject to the amount of Transient Occupancy Tax (TOT) allocated to each Councilmember in a given fiscal year. Granting Arts, Culture and Community Festivals (ACCF) funds is at the discretion of each Councilmember during the fiscal year.

B. Councilmembers may grant ACCF funds to nonprofit organizations that produce programs, projects, and events that provide access to excellence in culture and the arts for residents of, and visitors to, the City of San Diego (City), and enrich the lives of the people of San Diego and build healthy, vital neighborhoods.

C. Council Policy 100-23 requires each grant of ACCF funding to a nonprofit organization be done by Council resolution. Nonprofit organizations granted ACCF funds shall

enter an ACCF grant agreement with the City that specifies their responsibilities regarding the use of ACCF grant funds and stipulating that the nonprofit organization shall document all their expenses as required by the ACCF grant agreement.

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D. For Fiscal Year 2025, the Council approved Council District 2's \$10,000,
Council District 3's \$2,000, Council District 5's \$2,000, and Council District 6's \$2,000
recommended ACCF allocations to Meals-on-Wheels Greater San Diego, Inc., dba Meals on
Wheels San Diego (Meals on Wheels San Diego), by Resolutions R-316146 (Apr. 22, 2025),
R-316147 (Apr. 22, 2025), R-316183 (May 5, 2025), and R-316181(May 5, 2025), respectively.

E. Now, Council District 6 recommends allocating an additional \$2,000 in ACCF grant funds to Meals on Wheels San Diego for the Senior Art Walk, to be used as identified in the accompanying Staff Report (Staff Report) and supporting materials. If approved, the additional ACCF funds awarded to Meals on Wheels San Diego for the Senior Art Walk will be included in the revised ACCF Grant Agreement, which Council approved through R-316146, R-316147, R-316183, and R-316181, for an amount not to exceed \$18,000.

F. Council determines that the additional ACCF allocation to the Meals on Wheels San Diego described in the Staff Report and supporting materials conform to the parameters of Council Policy 100-23.

G. The Office of the City Attorney prepared this Resolution based on the information provided by City staff, including information provided by affected third parties and verified by City staff, with the understanding that this information is complete and accurate.

ACTION ITEMS

Be it resolved by the Council of the City of San Diego:

1. Council District 6's additional recommended Fiscal Year 2025 Arts, Culture and Community Festivals (ACCF) allocation to Meals-on-Wheels Greater San Diego, Inc., dba Meals on Wheels San Diego, for eligible uses pursuant to Council Policy 100-23 for the Senior Art Walk, as identified in the Staff Report and supporting materials, is approved.

2. The Mayor, or designee, is authorized to enter an Arts, Culture and Community Festivals Fiscal Year 2025 City Council Allocations Grant Agreement between the City of San Diego and Meals-on-Wheels Greater San Diego, Inc., dba Meals on Wheels San Diego, for the additional ACCF funds allocated under this Resolution.

3. The Chief Financial Officer is authorized to expend an amount not to exceed \$2,000 from Council District 6: TOT Fund 200205 / Cost Center 1414111217 / GL 512059, to provide funds to Meals-on-Wheels Greater San Diego, Inc., dba Meals on Wheels San Diego, for the Senior Art Walk, contingent upon the Chief Financial Officer first furnishing one or more certificates certifying that the funds necessary for expenditure are, or will be, on deposit with the City Treasurer.

4. The additional allocation described in this Resolution, Staff Report, and supporting materials is made for a public purpose.
