A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO APPROVING WAIVER OF POTENTIAL CONFLICTS OF INTEREST REQUESTED BY COLANTUONO, HIGHSMITH & WHATLEY, PC AND CONSENTING TO COLANTUONO, HIGHSMITH & WHATLEY, PC'S REPRESENTATION OF THE SAN DIEGO LOCAL AGENCY FORMATION COMMISSION IN ANTICIPATED LITIGATION BY THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AGAINST THE SAN DIEGO LOCAL AGENCY FORMATION COMMISSION

RECITALS

The Council of the City of San Diego (Council) adopts this Resolution based on the following:

A. The Colantuono, Highsmith & Whatley, PC law firm (the Law Firm) is currently representing the City of San Diego (City) in *Patz v. City of San Diego* (4th District Court of Appeal Case No. E083543) and in *Allred v. City of San Diego* (San Diego Superior Court Case No. 37-2021-00030939).

B. The Law Firm now seeks a conflict-of-interest waiver from the City so that it may represent the San Diego Local Agency Formation Commission (LAFCO) in an anticipated lawsuit by the City of San Diego against LAFCO challenging LAFCO's April 29, 2025, issuance of a Certificate of Sufficiency for "La Jolla Special Reorganization," LAFCO File No. SRO24-

15.

C. Under the California Rules of Professional Conduct, Rule 1.7, an attorney shall not, without the informed written consent, represent a client if the representation is directly adverse to another client in the same or separate matter.

D. The Law Firm's representation of LAFCO in any lawsuit brought by the City challenging LAFCO's issuance of the April 29, 2025, Certificate of Sufficiency for "La Jolla

Special Reorganization," LAFCO File No. SRO24-15 is completely unrelated to any legal services performed by the Law Firm on the City's behalf in *Patz v. City of San Diego* and in *Allred v. City of San Diego*. The *Patz* and *Allred* cases involve Proposition 218 challenges.

E. Granting the Law Firm's conflict-of-interest waiver does not pose a detrimental impact to the City and the Law Firm has obtained no confidential information relating to the City's anticipated lawsuit against LAFCO.

ACTION ITEMS

Be it resolved by the Council of the City of San Diego:

1. The Council grants the waiver of conflict-of-interest request by Colantuono, Highsmith & Whatley, PC, and consents to the Law Firm's representation of the San Diego Local Agency Formation Commission in the City of San Diego's anticipated lawsuit against the San Diego Local Agency Formation Commission, challenging the issuance of the Certificate of Sufficiency for "La Jolla Special Reorganization," LAFCO File No. SRO24-15
