A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO DETERMINING THAT APPROVAL OF A SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT FEE AND FEE SCHEDULE IS STATUTORILY EXEMPT FROM THE CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT PURSUANT TO CEQA GUIDELINES SECTION 15273.

<u>RECITALS</u>

The Council of the City of San Diego (Council) adopts this Resolution based on the following:

A. The Council will consider approval of a cost-recovery fee for City-provided solid waste management services, including, waste, recycling, and organic waste collection services, known as a "solid waste management fee," and adoption of a fee schedule for Fiscal Years 2026 through 2029 (Project).

B. The California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), California Public Resources Code (Code) sections 21000 through 21189.91, provides in Code section 21083 that the California Office of Planning and Research will promulgate, and the Secretary of the California Natural Resources Agency will adopt, guidelines for implementation of CEQA. The California Office of Planning and Research promulgated, and the Secretary of the California Natural Resources Agency adopted, the guidelines for implementation of CEQA set forth in Title 14 California Code of Regulations sections 15000 through 15387 (CEQA Guidelines).

C. Code section 21084 requires the CEQA Guidelines to include a list of classes of projects that have been determined not to have a significant effect on the environment and are

exempt from the provisions of CEQA. CEQA Guidelines sections 15260 through 15285 list the statutory CEQA exemptions promulgated by the California State Legislature.

D. The Council has considered the written record related to the Project and all public comments about the potential environmental effects of the Project. The Council, using its independent judgment, has determined that the Project is statutorily exempt from the provisions of CEQA under CEQA Guidelines section 15273 (Rates, Tolls, Fares, and Charges) because it involves the establishment, modification, structuring, restructuring, or approval of rates, tolls, fares, or other charges by public agencies that the public agency finds are for the purpose of: (1) meeting operating expenses, including employee wage rates and fringe benefits; (2) purchasing or leasing supplies, equipment, or materials; (3) meeting reserve needs and requirements; or (4) obtaining funds for capital projects necessary to maintain service within existing service areas.

E. The Office of the City Attorney prepared this Resolution based on the information provided by City staff (including information provided by affected third parties and verified by City staff), with the understanding that this information is complete and accurate.

ACTION ITEMS

Be it resolved by the Council of the City of San Diego:

1. The Project is statutorily exempt from the provisions of CEQA under CEQA Guidelines section 15273.

2. The City Clerk or designee is directed to file a Notice of Exemption in accordance
