A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
SAN DIEGO APPROVING THE FOURTH AMENDMENT TO
THE AGREEMENT WITH PATH SAN DIEGO FOR
COORDINATED STREET OUTREACH PROGRAM
SERVICES.

RECITALS

The Council of the City of San Diego (Council) adopts this Resolution based on the following:

A. The City of San Diego (City) entered into an agreement (Agreement) with PATH San Diego (PATH) to provide coordinated street outreach program services. The Agreement, effective July 14, 2022, has an initial term of one year (Initial Term) with compensation in an amount not to exceed \$3,000,000, and two one-year options to extend the term of the Agreement.

B. The City's Coordinated Street Outreach Program (Program) incorporates nationally recognized best practices and a neighborhood-based, person-centered approach to meet the needs of the City's unsheltered population. The Program actively engages individuals and households experiencing homelessness by focusing outreach resources.

C. PATH operates two types of response teams: (1) mobile response teams that work to locate and engage people identified as the most vulnerable and who are prioritized for resources, and (2) rapid response teams that focus on areas of high concentration and respond to community referrals providing immediate intervention and problem-solving activities.

D. By Resolution R-314462 (Nov. 28, 2022), the Council approved the First Amendment to the Agreement (First Amendment) to increase compensation by \$475,000, bringing the total compensation to an amount not to exceed \$3,475,000 during the Initial Term, and to amend the Agreement's scope of work.

E. By Resolution R-315015 (Jun. 30, 2023), the Council approved the Second Amendment to the Agreement (Second Amendment) to increase compensation by \$3,125,000 for services to be provided during the first option period, bringing the total compensation to an amount not to exceed \$6,600,000, and further revise the scope of work of the Agreement.

F. By Resolution R-315645 (Jul. 2, 2024), the Council approved the Third Amendment to the Agreement (Third Amendment) to increase compensation by \$3,500,000 for services to be provided during the second option period, bringing the total compensation to an amount not to exceed \$10,100,000.

G. The City and PATH now desire to enter into a Fourth Amendment to the Agreement (Fourth Amendment) to amend the Agreement to provide the City a third option to extend the term to June 30, 2026, and increase compensation by \$3,500,000 for services to be provided during the third option period, bringing the total compensation to an amount not to exceed \$13,600,000.

H. The Office of the City Attorney prepared this Resolution based on the information provided by City staff, with the understanding that this information is complete and accurate.

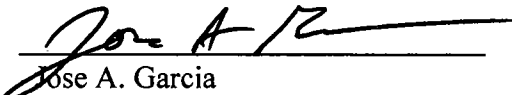
ACTION ITEMS

Be it resolved by the Council of the City of San Diego:

1. The Council approves the Fourth Amendment.
2. The Mayor or designee is authorized, on the City's behalf, to sign the Fourth Amendment.
3. The Chief Financial Officer is authorized to expend a total amount not to exceed \$3,500,00 for the purpose of providing for the increased compensation under the Agreement, as amended by the Fourth Amendment, during fiscal year 2026, contingent upon the adoption of the

Annual Appropriations Ordinance for fiscal year 2026 and the Chief Financial Officer first certifying that the funds necessary for expenditure are, or will be, on deposit with the City Treasurer.
