ORDINANCE NUMBER O- 22100 (NEW SERIES)

DATE OF FINAL PASSAGE JUN 15 2026

AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO WAIVING SAN DIEGO MUNICIPAL CODE SECTION 22.3105 LIMITS ON WORK PERFORMED BY CITY FORCES AND APPROVING AN EXPENDITURE NOT TO EXCEED \$2,400,000 FOR WORK BY CITY FORCES TO IMPLEMENT THE COMPREHENSIVE SPEED MANAGEMENT PLAN, AND RELATED ACTIONS.

RECITALS

The Council of the City of San Diego (Council) adopts this Ordinance based on the following:

A. Senate Bill 1 (SB 1), the Road Repair and Accountability Act of 2017 (Chapter 5, Statutes of 2017) was passed by the Legislature and signed into law by the Governor in April 2017 to address the significant multi-modal transportation funding shortfalls statewide.

B. For Fiscal Year 2027, the City of San Diego will receive an estimated \$39,532,696 in funding from the Road Maintenance and Rehabilitation Account (RMRA), created by SB 1.

C. City staff identified projects that are proposed to use RMRA funding, including identifying \$2,400,000 for work by City forces to perform engineering analysis and install related speed limit signage as part of the City's efforts to reduce speed limits under state law and implement the City's Comprehensive Speed Management Plan.

D. San Diego Municipal Code (Municipal Code) section 22.3105 limits the amount spent on work by City forces on public works projects to \$500,000. This action will waive that limitation to allow City forces to perform the \$2,400,000 in proposed work to implement the Comprehensive Speed Management Plan.

E. In compliance with the requirements in Municipal Code section 22.3105(a), the City Manager, through the Transportation Department, has determined that the use of City forces for this work is justified and will be more economical than if let by contract.

F. The Office of the City Attorney prepared this Ordinance based on the information provided by City staff (including information provided by affected third parties and verified by City staff), with the understanding that this information is complete and accurate.

ACTION ITEMS

Be it ordained by the Council of the City of San Diego:


Section 1. The \$500,000 threshold limit for work performed by City forces in Municipal Code section 22.3105 is waived and the Mayor, or designee, is authorized to use City forces in an amount not to exceed \$2,400,000 to perform engineering analysis and install related speed limit signage as part of the City's efforts to reduce speed limits under state law and implement the City's Comprehensive Speed Management Plan.

Section 2. The Chief Financial Officer is authorized to appropriate and expend an amount not to exceed \$2,400,000 from Fund 200731 – Road Maintenance & Rehabilitation Fund for City forces work related to the Comprehensive Speed Management Plan implementation, contingent upon the Chief Financial Officer furnishing certificates certifying that funds necessary for the construction contract expenditures are, or will be, on deposit with the City Treasurer.

Section 3. The Council dispenses with a full reading of this Ordinance before its passage because a written copy of this Ordinance was made available to the Council and the public before the date of its passage.

Section 4. This Ordinance will take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its final passage.
