AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF  
SAN DIEGO AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OR HIS  
DESIGNEE TO EXECUTE THE SECOND AMENDMENT TO  
THE AGREEMENT (H186974) WITH KLEINFELDER INC.  
FOR CONTINUED DESIGN AND CONSTRUCTION SUPPORT  
SERVICES OF THE LAKESIDE VALVE STATION  
REPLACEMENT PROJECT AND RELATED ACTIONS.

RECITALS

The Council of the City of San Diego (Council) adopts this Ordinance based on the following:

A. In January 2019, the City of San Diego (City) entered into a consultant agreement (H186974) with Kleinfelder, Inc., for professional design and construction support services (Agreement) in an amount not to exceed \$2,637,116 for the Lakeside Valve Station Replacement project (Project), with an original term expiring September 25, 2025.

B. On October 23, 2023, the Council approved Ordinance O-21736, which authorized a first amendment to the Agreement to extend the term to seven years and four months, and increased the Agreement's not-to-exceed amount by \$955,983 for additional design and construction support services associated with updated water facility design standards, additional County of San Diego permitting requirements, additional community outreach, and State Revolving Fund loan application requirements.

C. The Project is in the construction phase and has experienced delays from material procurement issues involving specialized 48-inch and 66-inch steel triple offset butterfly valves, construction resequencing required to maintain uninterrupted water delivery from the San Vicente and El Capitan Reservoirs to the Alvarado Water Treatment Plant, and extended

steel manufacturer lead times. Therefore, a second amendment to the Agreement is now necessary to extend the Agreement through December 15, 2027, at no additional cost to the City, to allow for continued design and construction support services (Second Amendment).

D. The Office of the City Attorney prepared this Ordinance based on the information provided by City staff (including information provided by affected third parties and verified by City staff), with the understanding that this information is complete and accurate.

E. The Second Amendment is subject to San Diego Charter section 99, which provides (subject to certain exceptions) that no contract, agreement, or obligation creating City indebtedness and extending for a period of more than five years may be authorized except by an ordinance adopted by a two-thirds majority of the Council.

#### ACTION ITEMS

Be it ordained by the Council of the City of San Diego:


Section 1. The Council authorizes the Second Amendment.

Section 2. The Mayor or designee is authorized, on behalf of the City, to sign the Second Amendment. When signed by both parties, the Second Amendment will be placed on file in the Office of the City Clerk as Document No. OO- 22108.

Section 3. The Council dispenses with a full reading of this Ordinance before its passage because a written copy of this Ordinance was made available to the Council and the public before the date of its passage.

Section 4. This Ordinance will take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its final passage.


