AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
SAN DIEGO AUTHORIZING THE SECOND AMENDMENT
TO THE AS-NEEDED TRANSPORTATION ENGINEERING
SERVICES AGREEMENT WITH KIMLEY-HORN AND
ASSOCIATES, INC. (H186985).

RECITALS

The Council of the City of San Diego (Council) adopts this Ordinance based on the following:

- A. The City of San Diego utilizes as-needed transportation engineering services agreements in support of its Capital Improvement Program (CIP) and other public projects.
- B. Being able to issue task orders under an as-needed agreement proves beneficial and efficient in the timely procurement of transportation engineering services.
- C. On August 23, 2019, the City executed the As-Needed Transportation Engineering Services Agreement (H186985) with Kimley-Horn and Associates, Inc. (Agreement), to provide transportation engineering services for CIP projects which include, but are not limited to, the preparation of construction drawings, contract documents, construction period services, and preparation of various reports as authorized by San Diego Resolution R-312510 (June 17, 2019).
- D. On October 21, 2024, the City executed a no-cost time extension only amendment to the Agreement (First Amendment) to extend the term of the Agreement from 60 months to 84 months as authorized by San Diego Ordinance O-21852 (Aug. 5, 2024).
- E. A second no-cost time extension only amendment to the Agreement (Second Amendment) will be necessary to extend the term of the Agreement from 84 months to 120 months to complete two remaining task orders that were issued under the Agreement.

F. This Second Amendment will allow the time needed for Kimley-Horn and Associates, Inc. to complete the following two task orders: Task Order 18TK06: Kensington Improvements 1 and Task Order 18TK11: Black Mountain Reservoir Spillway Access.

G. The Office of the City Attorney prepared this Ordinance based on the information provided by City staff, with the understanding that this information is complete and accurate.

H. The Second Amendment to the Agreement is subject to San Diego Charter section 99, which provides (subject to certain exceptions) that no contract, agreement, or obligation creating City indebtedness and extending for a period of more than five years may be authorized except by an ordinance adopted by a two-thirds majority of the Council.

ACTION ITEMS

Be it ordained by the Council of the City of San Diego:

Section 1. The Council approves the Second Amendment to the As-Needed Transportation Engineering Services Agreement (H186985) with Kimley-Horn and Associates, Inc.

Section 2. The Mayor or designee is authorized, on the City's behalf, to sign the Second Amendment with Kimley-Horn and Associates, Inc. When signed by both parties, the Second Amendment will be placed on file in the Office of the City Clerk as Document No.

OO- 22121.

Section 3. The Council dispenses with a full reading of this Ordinance before its passage because a written copy of this Ordinance was made available to the Council and the public before the date of its passage.

Section 4. This Ordinance will take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its final passage.

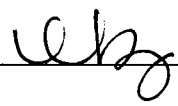

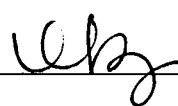
