AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
SAN DIEGO AUTHORIZING THE FIRST AMENDMENT TO
SOLE SOURCE AGREEMENT 4532 WITH OPENGOV, INC.
FOR ENTERPRISE ASSET MANAGEMENT SOLUTION
SOFTWARE SERVICES AND RELATED ACTIONS.

RECITALS

The Council of the City of San Diego (Council) adopts this Ordinance based on the following:

A. On December 29, 2022, the City of San Diego entered into a sole source agreement with OpenGov, Inc. to provide asset management software for managing the City's sidewalk, pavement, and tree inventories, in an amount not to exceed \$540,416.89 (Contract).

B. The asset management software provided by OpenGov has consistently met operational expectations, supported core Transportation Department workflows, and demonstrated strong reliability with minimal service disruption. The platform has become tightly integrated with City business processes, data structures, and downstream systems, making it a foundational component of service delivery.

C. The Transportation Department recently completed a Request for Information (RFI) to evaluate the current marketplace for pavement management systems and intends to proceed with a competitive Request for Proposals (RFP) for its long-term software needs. However, the competitive procurement, contract negotiation and approval, and potential implementation of a replacement system cannot reasonably be completed before the existing agreement expires on September 8, 2026.

D. The Transportation Department seeks to extend the Contract solely to maintain uninterrupted pavement management operations while the City completes the competitive

procurement process and, if necessary, transitions to the competitively selected solution.

Extending the existing OpenGov agreement provides operational continuity, protects the integrity of the City's historical pavement data, and avoids the cost and risk of implementing a temporary replacement system while preserving TD's commitment to competitively procuring its long-term pavement management solution

E. The First Amendment to the Contract extends the current subscription term by one year with an optional one-year renewal through September 8, 2028 and increases the not to exceed amount by \$237,562.07 (First Amendment), bringing the total not to exceed amount to \$777,978.96, as more fully set forth in the First Amendment which is included in the staff materials accompanying this Ordinance.

F. The Office of the City Attorney prepared this Ordinance based on the information provided by City staff (including information provided by affected third parties and verified by City staff), with the understanding that this information is complete and accurate.

G. The First Amendment is subject to San Diego Charter section 99, which provides (subject to certain exceptions) that no contract, agreement, or obligation creating City indebtedness and extending for a period of more than five years may be authorized except by an ordinance adopted by a two-thirds majority of the Council.

ACTION ITEMS

Be it ordained by the Council of the City of San Diego:

Section 1. The Council approves the First Amendment.

Section 2. The Mayor or designee is authorized, on the City's behalf, to sign the First Amendment. When signed by all parties, the First Amendment will be placed on file in the Office of the City Clerk as Document No. OO- **22145**.

Section 3. The Chief Financial Officer is authorized to expend an amount not to exceed \$237,562.07 from Fund 100000, General Fund, Business Area 2116, Transportation Department, for OpenGov, Inc. to continue the use of OMS (Cartegraph) Asset Management Solution, contingent upon the adoption of the Annual Appropriations Ordinance for the applicable fiscal years.

Section 4. The Council dispenses with a full reading of this Ordinance before its passage because a written copy of this Ordinance was made available to the Council and the public before the date of its passage.

Section 5. This Ordinance will take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its final passage.

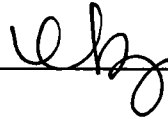

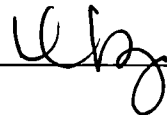
