A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AUTHORIZING AWARD OF AN AGREEMENT IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$4,441,148.39 WITH NRC ENVIRONMENTAL SERVICES, INC. TO PROVIDE AS-NEEDED JETTING AND PIPE CLEANING SERVICES AT PUBLIC UTILITIES DEPARTMENT WASTEWATER TREATMENT FACILITIES AND RELATED ACTIONS.

RECITALS

The Council of the City of San Diego (Council) adopts this Resolution based on the following:

A. The City of San Diego (City) Public Utilities Department (PUD) operates wastewater treatment facilities (Facilities) where heavy organic materials, fats, oils, and grease accumulate within various components of the facilities.

B. In order to ensure reliable operations, maintain system capacity, and prevent operational issues that could lead to equipment damage, process disruptions, or permit compliance issues, the Facilities must be periodically cleaned. The cleaning process requires specialized equipment and trained personnel due to confined spaces that require specialized safety procedures; atmospheric monitoring; ventilation; and trained teams for jetting, flushing, removing, and disposing hazardous materials in compliance with environmental regulations (Services).

C. The City seeks to retain a contractor to provide these Services on an as-needed basis at PUD Facilities including North City Water Reclamation Plant, Point Loma Wastewater Treatment Plant, and South Bay Water Reclamation Plant.

D. In December 2025, the City issued an Invitation to Bid (ITB) to solicit the Services. Three firms submitted timely and responsive proposals. City staff selected NRC Environmental Services, Inc. as the lowest responsible and responsive bidder.

E. The City now desires to retain NRC Environmental Services, Inc. (Contractor) to provide the Services. The terms of the agreement, included in the docket materials accompanying this Resolution, are for an initial term of one year, with up to four one-year options to renew, in an amount not to exceed \$4,441,148.39 (Agreement).

F. The Office of the City Attorney prepared this Resolution based on the information provided by City staff (including information provided by affected third parties and verified by City staff), with the understanding that this information is complete and accurate.

ACTION ITEMS

Be it resolved by the Council of the City of San Diego:


1. The Council approves the Agreement.
2. The Mayor or designee is authorized, on the City's behalf, to sign the Agreement.

When signed by both parties, the Agreement will be placed on file in the Office of the City Clerk as Document No. RR- 316794.

3. The Chief Financial Officer is authorized to appropriate and expend an amount not to exceed \$4,441,148.39, from Fund 700001, Metro Sewer Utility Fund, for the purpose of funding the Agreement, contingent upon the adoption of the Annual Appropriation Ordinance for

the applicable fiscal year, and contingent upon the Chief Financial Officer first certifying that the funds necessary for expenditure are, or will be, on deposit with the City Treasurer.


