A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
SAN DIEGO CONFIRMING AN APPOINTMENT TO THE
BOARD OF BUILDING APPEALS AND ADVISORS.

RECITALS

The Council of the City of San Diego (Council) adopts this Resolution based on the following:

A. San Diego Municipal Code section 111.0207 (Municipal Code) established the Board of Building Appeals and Advisors (Board) to investigate and advise the Building Official on the suitability of any alternate material, design, or construction method; recommend reasonable interpretations of the San Diego Fire Code and the Building, Electrical, Plumbing, Mechanical, Residential Building, Green Building, and Existing Building Regulations of Title 24 of the California Code of Regulations (Building Regulations), among other matters that may be referred to the Board by the Building Official; recommend minor deviation from the provisions of the San Diego Fire Code and the Building Regulations under certain circumstances; and conduct public hearings upon the passage of new legislation pertaining to the design and construction of building and provide its recommendations to the Council.

B. The Municipal Code provides that the Board consists of ten members appointed by the Mayor, subject to confirmation by a majority vote of the Council. The Municipal Code provides that the Mayor shall appoint at least two members licensed by the State of California as Civil Engineers, one of whom is duly authorized to use the title "Structural Engineer," and one member each from the electrical and mechanical industries or professions; at least two members licensed by the State of California as Fire Protection Engineers; at least one member licensed by

the State of California as an Architect; and at least one member to represent the disabled community.

C. Members shall have experience and training in matters of design and construction of buildings, fire prevention, and fire protection.

D. Members serve two-year terms and until a successor is duly appointed and confirmed. No more than five members may have terms that expire in any year.

E. The Office of the City Attorney has drafted this resolution based on the information provided by City staff, including information provided by affected third parties and verified by City staff, with the understanding that this information is complete and accurate.

Be it resolved by the Council of the City of San Diego:


1. The following appointment by the Mayor, to serve as a member of the Board of Building Appeals and Advisors, for a term expiring as indicated, is made and hereby confirmed:
