DATE OF FINAL PASSAGE **JUL 14 2026**

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OR HIS DESIGNEE TO APPLY FOR AND ACCEPT GRANT FUNDS FROM THE CALIFORNIA GOVERNOR'S OFFICE OF EMERGENCY SERVICES, AND TO ENTER INTO ALL AGREEMENTS NECESSARY TO IMPLEMENT THE FISCAL YEAR 2025 HOMELAND SECURITY GRANT PROGRAM; AND AUTHORIZING THE CHIEF FINANCIAL OFFICER OR DESIGNEE TO ACCEPT, APPROPRIATE, AND EXPEND GRANT FUNDS AWARDED UNDER THE FISCAL YEAR 2025 HOMELAND SECURITY GRANT PROGRAM.

RECITALS

The Council of the City of San Diego (Council) adopts this Resolution based on the following:

- A. The City of San Diego (City) has been identified by the United States Department of Homeland Security (DHS) as the San Diego Urban Area (SDUA) "core city" for the federal Fiscal Year (FY) 2025 Urban Area Security Initiative (UASI), an element of the FY 2025 Homeland Security Grant Program (HSGP).
- B. The SDUA is defined as the 18 incorporated cities in San Diego County, the unincorporated areas of the county, and the related special districts.
- C. As the core city, the City will be the grantee and administrator of the UASI grant program for the entire SDUA.
- D. The FY 2025 UASI program addresses the unique planning, organization, equipment, training, and exercise needs of high-threat, high-density Urban Areas, and assists them in building enhanced and sustainable capacities to prevent, protect against, mitigate, respond to, and recover from acts of terrorism.

E. The DHS provides UASI funds through the California Governor's Office of Emergency Services, which grants them to the City to administer for the entire SDUA.

F. There is no non-federal match or cost share required for grants under the UASI program, however, these grants are reimbursable in nature, requiring the City to expend funds prior to requesting reimbursement.

G. The FY 2025 UASI grant amount for the SDUA is \$17,716,678 and will be spent over multiple fiscal years, and additional reallocated grant funds could increase the SDUA's FY 2025 HSGP award further.

H. Expenditures will be initially sourced from fund 600000 (Grant Fund - Federal) and then reimbursed from the federal FY 2025 HSGP.

I. City Council approval is required pursuant to San Diego Municipal Code section 22.5204.

J. The Office of the City Attorney prepared this Resolution based on the information provided by City staff with the understanding that this information is complete and accurate.

ACTION ITEMS

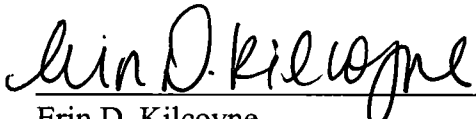
Be it resolved by the Council of the City of San Diego:

1. The Mayor, or his designee, is authorized to apply for and accept \$17,716,678 and any additional grant funding from the California Governor's Office of Emergency Services to implement the FY 2025 HSGP.

2. The Mayor, or his designee, is authorized to enter into all agreements necessary for the purpose of implementing the FY 2025 HSGP, contingent on funding being secured.

3. The Chief Financial Officer is authorized to accept, appropriate, and expend an amount not to exceed \$17,716,678, and any additional grant funding awarded under the FY 2025 HSGP, contingent upon receipt of a fully executed Grant Agreement if the Grant funding is secured.

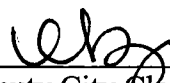

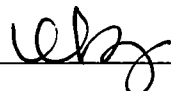
