A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
SAN DIEGO FOR THE FIRST AMENDMENT TO
COOPERATIVE PROCUREMENT CONTRACT BETWEEN
THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AND CINTAS CORPORATION
NO. 2 FOR UNIFORM AND FIRE PROTECTION EQUIPMENT
SERVICES.

RECITALS

The Council of the City of San Diego (Council) adopts this Resolution based on the following:

A. On September 17, 2024, the City of San Diego (City) entered into an As-Needed Citywide Cooperative Agreement (Contract) with Cintas Corporation No. 2 (Contractor) utilizing a competitively awarded cooperative agreement administered through the University of Nebraska and OMNIA Partners. The Contract provides uniform rental services, laundering, repairs, replacements, and fire protection equipment services for City departments on an as-needed basis.

B. The Contract provides critical services to the City ensuring access to clean professional uniforms, maintained safety apparel, and fire protection equipment that comply with the City's obligations to its employees.

C. Additional funds are needed to meet operational demands to continue providing the required uniform and equipment-related services that are necessary to support daily operations, employee safety, and compliance with applicable regulatory requirements.

D. This proposed amendment to the Contract will increase the not-to-exceed amount from \$3,000,000.00 to \$6,300,000 for as-needed City-wide services.

E. The Office of the City Attorney prepared this Resolution based on the information provided by City staff with the understanding that this information is complete and accurate.

ACTION ITEMS

Be it resolved by the Council of the City of San Diego:

1. The Mayor or designee is authorized to approve and execute the First Amendment to the As-Needed Citywide Cooperative Procurement Agreement with Cintas Corporation No. 2 to increase the not-to-exceed amount of \$3,000,000 to \$6,300,000 for uniform and fire protection services, and otherwise modify the Contract pursuant to the terms and conditions set forth in the First Amendment to the Contract on file with the City Clerk as Document No. RR-

316863

2. The Chief Financial Officer is authorized to expend an amount not-to-exceed \$6,300,000 over the full term of the Contract, as amended, contingent upon the adoption of the Annual Appropriation Ordinance for the applicable fiscal years and contingent on the Chief Financial Officer furnishing one or more certificates certifying that funds necessary for expenditure are, or will be, on deposit with the City Treasurer.
