A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
SAN DIEGO TO ACCEPT, APPROPRIATE, AND EXPEND A
HOMELESS HOUSING, ASSISTANCE, AND PREVENTION
ROUND 6 GRANT FROM THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA.

RECITALS

The Council of the City of San Diego (Council) adopts this Resolution based on the following:

A. The Homeless Housing, Assistance, and Prevention Grant Program (HHAP) is a State of California (State) block grant available for large cities, counties, and continuums of care designed to support local jurisdictions in their unified regional response to reduce and end homelessness.

B. The City of San Diego (City) was previously awarded approximately \$22.5 million for the HHAP Round 1 grant in 2020, approximately \$10.6 million in HHAP Round 2 grant funds in 2021, approximately \$27.5 million in HHAP Round 3 grant funds in 2022, approximately \$22.4 million in HHAP Round 4 grant funds in 2023, and approximately \$29.9 million in HHAP Round 5 grant funds in 2025.

C. In February 2025, the California Department of Housing and Community Development (HCD) announced the availability of the HHAP Round 6 (HHAP 6) grant funding. The intent of HHAP 6 is to reflect the State's priorities to prevent and expeditiously reduce unsheltered homelessness through homelessness prevention activities with an emphasis on funding Permanent Housing Solutions and sustaining existing Interim Housing Solutions, including long-term sustainability of permanent affordable housing.

D. Eligible uses identified in the HHAP 6 grant include rapid rehousing, operating subsidies, street outreach, services coordination, systems support for activities, delivery of

permanent housing and innovative housing solutions, prevention and shelter diversion, interim shelters, and improvements to existing emergency shelters to lower barriers and increase privacy.

E. On July 14, 2025, the Homelessness Strategies and Solutions Department (HSSD) presented an informational item to the Council to provide an overview of the City's HHAP 6 application and proposed expenditures of the HHAP 6 funding, including funding for the City's Safe Parking Program.

F. HCD issued a Frequently Asked Questions document confirming safe parking is an eligible use under category four, but HCD guidance and other documents revealed a strong application should focus allocations on the first three categories of permanent housing solutions, homelessness prevention activities, and interim housing solutions. As a result, HSSD revised the application accordingly.

G. On July 31, 2025, the City's grants review team approved HSSD's request to apply for HHAP 6 grant funds.

H. On August 29, 2025, the City, in partnership with the County of San Diego (County) and Regional Task Force on Homelessness (RTFH), submitted a joint application for the San Diego region. On December 23, 2025, HCD notified the agencies of their individual awards including \$25,844,167.11 for the City, \$12,101,261.03 for the County, and \$12,924,354.84 for the RTFH.

I. The City intends to use the awarded HHAP 6 grant funds for the proposed programmatic expenditures identified in the chart below in compliance with the eligible uses for HHAP 6 funds.

J. The Office of the City Attorney prepared this Resolution based on the information provided by City staff, with the understanding that this information is complete and accurate.

ACTION ITEMS

Be it resolved by the Council of the City of San Diego:

1. The Mayor, or designee, is authorized, on the City's behalf, to accept the HHAP 6 grant award in the amount of \$25,844,167.11.
2. The Mayor, or designee, is authorized to negotiate and execute an agreement with HCD for the HHAP 6 grant award and any renewals and amendments, as needed.
3. The Mayor, or designee, is authorized to execute all documents and instruments that are necessary and appropriate to implement this Resolution.
4. The Chief Financial Officer is authorized to appropriate and expend HHAP 6 grant funds in an amount not to exceed \$25,844,167.11 for the proposed allocations by eligible use category identified in the chart below, subject to state approval, and allowing for the adjustment of the estimated amount as approved by HCD provided the total expenditure does not exceed \$25,844,167.11.

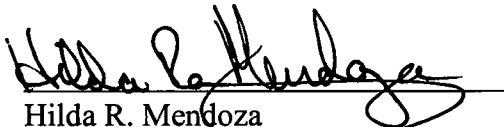
5. The Mayor, or designee, is authorized upon appropriation, to reallocate any portion of the HHAP 6 grant funds allocated to one category to one or more eligible uses within a separate category without the need for further Council approval if the reallocation is approved by the HCD HHAP 6 Grant Manager, or designee, in writing, before expending money pursuant to an alternative budget.

6. The Mayor, or designee, is authorized to take all necessary or appropriate actions to administer, monitor, amend, manage, and ensure compliance with the HHAP 6 grant agreement, and, when required, to develop, advertise, negotiate, and award contracts to third parties to implement the HHAP 6 grant agreement or the City's use of the grant funds.

7. The Chief Financial Officer is authorized to establish a special interest-bearing account for the grant, if required, the proceeds of which will be used for any eligible uses outlined in the HHAP 6 grant agreement.

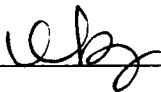
