A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
SAN DIEGO CONFIRMING REAPPOINTMENTS TO THE
SENIOR AFFAIRS ADVISORY BOARD.

RECITALS

The Council of the City of San Diego (Council) adopts this Resolution based on the following:

A. The Senior Affairs Advisory Board (Board) is established in San Diego Municipal Code sections 26.1501 through 26.1503 (Municipal Code) to advise the Mayor and Council on matters that directly impact seniors, including transportation, security at home, improved intergenerational interaction, meal delivery, housing, and improved City-County cooperation.

B. The Municipal Code also states that the Board shall make recommendations for improving communications between seniors and City of San Diego (City) government; review City employment policies for seniors; perform studies and surveys as requested by the Mayor and Council; advise on relevant issues and formation of laws, policies, or procedures which may affect seniors; and report annually to the Mayor and Council on the "State of the Seniors" within the City.

C. The Municipal Code provides that the Board will consist of 11 members, appointed by the Mayor and confirmed by the Council, who shall serve without compensation. Of the 11 members, seven shall be Senior Service Delivery Professionals/Experts and four shall be City-at-Large Seniors (more than 60 years old).

D. Under the Municipal Code members shall serve two-year terms and each member shall serve until a successor is duly appointed and confirmed. The Municipal Code requires

terms to expire on May 31 and does not allow more than six members to have terms expiring in a given year.

E. The Office of the City Attorney has drafted this resolution based on the information provided by City staff, including information provided by affected third parties and verified by City staff, with the understanding that this information is complete, true and accurate.

ACTION ITEMS

Be it resolved by the Council of the City of San Diego:

1. The following reappointments by the Mayor of the City of San Diego, to serve as members of the Senior Affairs Advisory Board, for terms expiring as indicated, are made and hereby confirmed:

therefore, a conscious exception to Council Policy 000-13 is hereby declared.

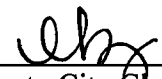
