A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO DETERMINING THAT THE EXTENSION OF SOLE SOURCE CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT K-21-2029-SLS-2 WITH DUDEK AND APPROVAL OF CHANGE ORDER NO. 1 FOR LONG TERM MAINTENANCE AND MONITORING SERVICES OF THE CREST CANYON PARK EMERGENCY STORM DRAIN REPLACEMENT PROJECT ARE STATUTORILY EXEMPT FROM THE CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT UNDER PUBLIC RESOURCES CODE SECTIONS 21080(B)(2) AND (B)(4) AND CEQA GUIDELINES SECTION 15269(B) AND 15269(C).

RECITALS

The Council of the City of San Diego (Council) adopts this Resolution based on the following:

A. The Council will consider the extension of the sole source construction contract K-21-2029-SLS-2 with Dudek (Contractor) and approval of Construction Change Order No. 1 for long-term maintenance and monitoring services of the Crest Canyon Emergency Storm Drain Replacement Project (Project).

B. The California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), California Public Resources Code (Code) sections 21000-21189.91, provides in Code section 21083 that the California Office of Planning and Research will promulgate, and the Secretary of the California Natural Resources Agency will adopt guidelines for implementation of CEQA. The California Office of Planning and Research promulgated, and the Secretary of the California Natural Resources Agency adopted the guidelines for implementation of CEQA set forth in Title 14 California Code of Regulations sections 15000 through 15387 (CEQA Guidelines).

C. Code section 21084 requires the CEQA Guidelines to include a list of classes of projects that have been determined not to have a significant effect on the environment and are

exempt from the provisions of CEQA. CEQA Guidelines sections 15260 through 15285 list the statutory CEQA exemptions promulgated by the California Legislature.

D. The Council has considered the written record related to the Project and all public comments about the potential environmental effects of the Project. The Council, using its independent judgment, has determined that the Project is statutorily exempt from the provisions of CEQA under CEQA Guidelines sections 15269(b) and 15269(c) (title “Emergency Projects”).

E. The Office of the City Attorney prepared this Resolution based on the information provided by City staff (including information provided by affected third parties and verified by City staff), with the understanding that this information is complete and accurate.

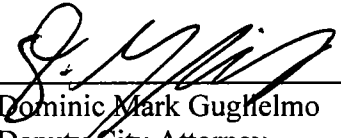
ACTION ITEMS

Be it resolved by the Council of the City of San Diego:

1. The extension of sole source construction contract K-21-2029-SLS-2 and approval of Change Order No. 1 for the Project are statutorily exempt from the provisions of CEQA under CEQA Guidelines sections 15269(b) and 15269(c) and Code sections 21080(b)(2) and 21080(b)(4).

2. The City Clerk or designee is directed to file a CEQA Notice of Exemption regarding the Project with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors for the County of San Diego and the State Clearinghouse in the Office of Land Use and Climate Innovation.

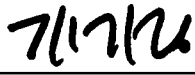
