A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
SAN DIEGO TO ADOPT THE FIRST AMENDMENT TO
CITYWIDE CONTRACT FOR AS-NEEDED INSTALLATION,
REPAIR, AND RENTAL OF FENCES, GATES, NETS, AND
BARRIERS.

RECITALS

The Council of the City of San Diego (Council) adopts this Resolution based on the following:

- A. This action seeks to amend the Citywide Contract for As-Needed Installation, Repair and Rental of Fences, Gates, Nets, and Barriers with All Around Fencing, Inc. (Contractor) to increase the not-to-exceed amount. This amendment will ensure the City departments are able to have continued access to fencing services that are critical to their operational needs.
- B. On October 27, 2023, the City of San Diego (City) issued an Invitation to Bid (10089851-24-G) for As-Needed Installation, Repair and Rental of Fences, Gates, Nets, and Barriers resulting in a contract with the apparent low responsive and responsible bidder, Contractor, for a five-year contract in an amount not-to-exceed \$3,000,000 on April 12, 2024 (Contract).
- C. The Contract was made available City-wide for all departments to use for various fencing needs, which has resulted in surpassing the expected usage of these fencing-related services. Notably the Public Utilities Department (PUD), Homelessness Strategies (HSSD), and

Parks and Recreation Department (P&R) have needed substantial fencing services to address arising safety concerns at various City of San Diego locations.

D. Additional funds are needed to meet operational demands to reduce safety concerns for damaged park fences Citywide, ensure rapid repairs to protect the public and city assets, reinforce public safety protection at PUD work sites, and maintain a safe environment for residents during pool maintenance, repairs or closures.

E. This proposed amendment to the Contract will increase the not-to-exceed amount from \$3,000,000.00 to \$8,900,000 and clarify that the services to be provided are for temporary fencing, services, and maintenance rather than erecting permanent fences City-wide.

F. The Office of the City Attorney prepared this Resolution based on the information provided by City staff with the understanding that this information is complete and accurate.

ACTION ITEMS

Be it resolved by the Council of the City of San Diego:

1. The Mayor or designee is authorized to approve and execute the First Amendment to the As-Needed Citywide Contract with All Around Fencing to increase the not-to-exceed amount from \$3,000,000.00 to \$8,900,000 and to otherwise modify the Agreement pursuant to the terms and conditions contained in the First Amendment to the Contract on file with the City Clerk as Document No. RR- 316887.

2. The Chief Financial Officer is authorized to expend an amount not-to-exceed \$8,900,000 over the full term of the Contract, as amended, contingent upon the adoption of the Annual Appropriation Ordinance for the applicable fiscal years and contingent on the Chief Financial Officer furnishing one or more certificates certifying that funds necessary for expenditure are, or will be, on deposit with the City Treasurer.

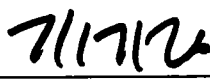
