A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
SAN DIEGO TO APPROVE APPLICATION, ACCEPTANCE,
APPROPRIATION, AND EXPENDITURE OF PROPOSITION 4
GRANT FUNDS FROM THE SAN DIEGO RIVER
CONSERVANCY FOR THE BEYER PARK DEVELOPMENT
PHASE II PROJECT.

RECITALS

The Council of the City of San Diego (Council) adopts this Resolution based on the following:

A. The San Diego River Conservancy is a state agency established in 2002 to protect and enhance the San Diego River watershed (Agency). The Agency administers the Proposition 4 Grant Program to support multi-benefit projects that advance watershed health and community resilience.

B. Proposition 4, which is formally known as the Safe Drinking Water, Wildfire Prevention, Drought Preparedness, and Clean Air Bond of 2024 was approved by voters to fund initiatives that strengthen wildfire resilience, restore natural landscapes, improve water quality, expand public access, and address climate-related risks to communities, wildlife, and natural resources.

C. Through this grant program, the Agency directs funding to projects aligned with its statutory mission, strategic plan, and statewide priorities, with a significant focus on delivering meaningful benefits to disadvantaged and vulnerable communities.

D. The City of San Diego (City) wishes to apply for and receive up to \$2,000,000 in grant funding for the Beyer Park Development Phase II Project and will enter into an agreement with the Agency to do so.

E. The Beyer Park Development Phase II Project (Project) will provide for the design and construction of approximately eight acres of developed parkland, 14 acres of habitat restoration, and 21 acres of undeveloped open space land. In particular, the Project provides for a pedestrian walkway, dog park, comfort station, picnic facilities, maintenance building, parking lot, and athletic fields. The Project has a total estimated cost of approximately \$18 million.

F. The Office of the City Attorney prepared this Resolution based on the information provided by City staff, with the understanding that this information is complete and accurate.

ACTION ITEMS

Be it resolved by the Council of the City of San Diego:

1. The Council approves the filing of an application for grant funds for the Project.
2. The Council certifies that the City understands the assurances and certification in the application.
3. The Council certifies that the City will have sufficient funds to operate and maintain the Project consistent with the land tenure requirements or will secure the resources to do so.
4. The Council certifies that the City will comply with all provisions of Section 1771.5 of the California Labor Code.
5. The Council certifies that, if applicable, the Project will comply with any laws and regulations including, but not limited to, the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), legal requirements for building codes, health and safety codes, disabled access laws, and that prior to commencement of construction, all applicable permits will have been obtained.

6. The Council certifies that the City will work towards the State Planning Priorities intended to promote equity, strengthen the economy, protect the environment, and promote public health and safety as included in Government Code Section 65041.1.

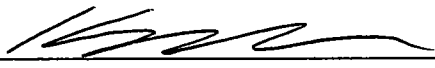
7. The Council appoints and authorizes the Mayor or designee to conduct all negotiations, execute, and submit all documents, including, but not limited to, applications, agreements, amendments, and payment requests, and to take all necessary actions to secure the grant funding in an amount not-to-exceed \$2,000,000 for the Project and for the completion of the Project.

8. The Chief Financial Officer is authorized to accept, appropriate, and expend an amount not-to-exceed \$2,000,000 in grant program funding for the Beyer Park Development Phase II Project, CIP S23008, if the grant funding is secured, and contingent upon the Chief Financial Officer furnishing one or more certificates that funds are, or will be, on deposit with the City Treasurer.

9. The Chief Financial Officer is authorized to increase the Capital Improvement Project (CIP) Program Budget in CIP S23008, Beyer Park Development Phase II Project, and to appropriate and expend an amount not-to-exceed \$2,000,000 from Fund 600001, Grant Fund – State, for the purpose of design and construction of the Project, contingent upon receipt of a fully executed grant agreement and contingent upon the Chief Financial Officer furnishing one or more certificates that funds are, or will be, on deposit with the City Treasurer.

10. The Chief Financial Officer is authorized to establish a special interest-bearing account for the grant if the grant funding described above is secured, and to deposit grant funds received in such account.

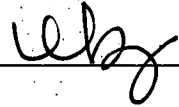
