- HEALTH AND HOMELESSNESS INEXTRICABLY LINKED.
 HEALTHCARE COSTS FOR THOSE LIVING ON THE STREETS IS ASTRONOMICAL –ER, Ambulance
- PRIMARYHEALTHCARE OFTEN THE GATEWAY TO OTHER SERVICES, SUCH AS MENTAL HEALTH OR SUBSTANCE ABUSE TREATMENT, AND HOUSING
