REQUESTED ACTION:

This action is to transfer TransNet American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA) funds from the City of San Diego to the City Redevelopment Agency to fund the Front and Cedar Traffic Signal Project.

STAFF RECOMMENDATION:

Staff recommendation is to approve the resolution.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

On September 27, 2007, a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) for the Project was executed between the City and Corporation. The MOU between the City and the Corporation is for the design and installation of a traffic signal at the intersection of Front and Cedar Streets. The project consisted of a traffic signal, pop-outs for the northern corners and other surface improvements required for drainage and ADA compliance. The City funded the traffic signal design and will be responsible for maintaining the traffic signal and the Corporation was responsible for the construction of the Project. The Project was part of a public works project to install a total of six traffic signals throughout downtown San Diego.

This action authorizes the City to reimburse the Redevelopment Agency (RDA) for the project. The Redevelopment Agency through the Centre City Development Corporation funded \$59,910 towards the total project cost of \$343,310.

FISCAL CONSIDERATIONS:

\$283,400 will be transferred to the Redevelopment Agency (RDA) from CIP#A-IK.00004.

PREVIOUS COUNCIL COMMITTEE ACTION:


Resolution Number R-305177 dated August 19, 2009 authorized the City to accept \$283,400 in SANDAG TransNet/ARRA funds specifically for this project.
