Background



- City 60-inch storm drain under Lindbergh Field, TDY (formerly Teledyne Ryan Aeronautical) to Convair Lagoon
- Polychlorinated biphenyls (PCBs) were found in the sediments in Convair Lagoon in the 1980's
- Cap placed on contaminated sediments in 1990s by the Port of San Diego
- Currently, PCBs are found on the cap and in the 60-inch storm drain
