

Prop 84 ASBS Grant Approval

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Grant Source



- City applied for and was selected for an award of \$2.5M SWRCB Grant funding.
- \$1.69M identified for the Avenida de La Playa Storm (Low Flow Diversion) Project.
- Balance of the funding (\$810K) identified for BMP monitoring, assessment, studies and Outreach
- No additional expenditures are needed for matching funds



Avenida De La Playa Storm Drain



- Project located in the La Jolla Area of Special Biological Significance (ASBS)
- Storm Drain undersized for drainage area
- Street subject to flooding and other problems
- Will increase storm drain a capacity and include low-flow diversions to reduce pollutant loads in dry weather.
- Expected completion date Summer 2013




Figure 1. Avenida De La Play Post Storm.




Figure 2. Pumped Dry Weather Diverter.
