


Water Supply

- Total 11% reduction in water usage for FY 2010
- Exceeded our 8% reduction goal
- Regional and local reservoirs have seen improvements in storage levels (recorded as of August 27, 2010):
 - Oroville – 60% full (40% last year)
 - Powell (Colorado River) – 64% full (same)
 - Diamond (MWD) – 62% full (48% last year)
 - City of San Diego reservoirs, on average, are 54% full.




Annual Water Use (AF)






July Billed Consumption (AF)

Total investigations opened through July 2010: 6,053



Top 3 water waste types reported:

1. Watering wrong day or >3x/week
2. Excessive irrigation
3. Water runoff
