EXECUTIVE SUMMARY OF ITEM BACKGROUND:

The San Diego Fire-Rescue Community Emergency Response Team (CERT) helps train citizens to be better prepared to respond to and cope with the aftermath of a disaster. Some areas of training are disaster Preparedness, fire Safety, medical triage and treatment, light search and rescue. CERT was recently awarded a grant in the amount of \$2500 from the San Diego Gas & Electric (SDG&E) mini-grant program. This fund will provide CERT with support for the areas of emergency preparedness training, community education and outreach, and volunteer recruitment and retention programs. CERT San Diego will use these funds to support its post-academy training efforts by purchasing consumables, small tools, and educational materials for recruiting new members.

FISCAL CONSIDERATIONS:

There is no impact to the General Fund. An amount of \$2,500 will be deposited into the specified grant fund and an equal amount will be spent off the same account within FY2011, resulting in a net-zero impact.
