In response to your memo dated March 24, 2010, "Council Policy 100-03 and Mayor/ City Council TOT Allocations," we would like to request a review and analysis of amendments to CP 100-03 that would be needed to allow the City Council to continue funding district by district allocations within the Special Promotional Programs portion of the City Budget.

This review and analysis should include the above requested amendments, any alternatives available in managing contracts under CP 100-03 and steps to maximize Arts and Culture discretionary funds within the City Charter and Municipal Code.

In order to ensure current Council allocations for FY 2010, we'd like to propose waiving Council Policy 100-03 until sufficient policy changes have been made. Organizations currently processing individual council allocation contracts will be negatively affected by any action precluding them from obtaining funding this fiscal year.

This matter will be docketed at the next available Rules, Open Government, and Intergovernmental Relations Committee meeting.
