**DESCRIPTIVE SUMMARY OF ITEM:**

Council authorization is requested to advertise and award a construction contract for Sewer Group Job 785A Accelerated. The work will consist of the installation of approximately 4,889 linear-feet (LF) of 8-inch and 60 linear feet (LF) of 10-inch sewer mains, and 33 sewer manholes. This project is located in City right-of-way and easements within developed streets in the Clairemont Mesa and Linda Vista Community areas.

**STAFF RECOMMENDATION:**

Adopt the resolutions.

**EXECUTIVE SUMMARY OF ITEM BACKGROUND:**

Sewer Group Job 785A Accelerated is part of the City of San Diego's Sewer Main Replacement Program as mandated by the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA). This project is located in City right-of-way and easements within developed streets in the Clairemont Mesa and Linda Vista Community areas. The streets that will be affected by the construction operations within this project are: Morena Boulevard, Vega Street, Viola Street, Savannah Street, Tecolote Road, Naples Street, West Morena Boulevard, Hartford Street, Jellett Street, Ingulf Place, and associated alleys. The work will consist of the installation of approximately 4,889 linear-feet (LF) of 8-inch and 60 linear feet (LF) of 10-inch sewer mains, and 33 sewer manholes. Additional work will include sewer lateral installation, trench shoring, street resurfacing, and curb ramp construction. The contractor will also prepare traffic control shop drawings for all streets that require traffic control. Upon approval by the City, the contractor will implement these traffic control measures as required by the drawings.

**FISCAL CONSIDERATIONS:**

The total estimated cost of this project is \$2,278,721. Enterprise Funding of \$2,278,721 is available from CIP A-JA.00003, Annual Allocation – Unscheduled Projects (B-00495), Fund 700000, Sewer, for this purpose. The project costs may be reimbursed approximately 80% by current or future debt financing. This project is funded in Fiscal Year 2011. No future funding is anticipated for this project. A Comptroller Certificate will be provided prior to contract award.

**EQUAL OPPORTUNITY CONTRACTING INFORMATION (IF APPLICABLE):**

Funding Agency: City of San Diego – Prevailing wages do not apply to this contract.

As part of the approved Small Local Business Enterprise (SLBE) Program subcontracting goals are established for each City funded contract based on the scope of work and availability of certified firms. (See the B-page.) The contractors must solicit bids from the City of San Diego's

most-currently-approved SLBE List of participants. Failure to comply with mandatory goals or successfully submit the required Good Faith Efforts documentation will lead to the bid being rejected. Prior to award, a work force report, and if necessary, an Equal Opportunity Plan must be submitted by the apparent low bidder. EOC staff will monitor the compliance with the applicable ordinances (i.e., Municipal Code Sections 18173, 22.2701 through 22.27-8, and 22.3501 through 22.3517).

The City contracts are advertised in one or more of the following media sources: San Diego Daily Transcript, the City of San Diego's website, or a third party online service e.g., the eBidboard.

**PREVIOUS COUNCIL and/or COMMITTEE ACTIONS:**

The subject item will be presented to the Committee on Natural Resources and Culture prior in February 2011, prior to the Council docket date.

**COMMUNITY PARTICIPATION AND PUBLIC OUTREACH EFFORTS:**

A project presentation was given to the Linda Vista Community Board on September 9, 2010. In addition, residents and businesses will be notified at least one month prior to construction by the City's Engineering and Capital Projects Department and again, ten days before construction begins by the contractor through hand distribution of notices.

**KEY STAKEHOLDERS AND PROJECTED IMPACTS:**

The key stakeholders are identified as the public and the City of San Diego. In most locations, residents surrounding the project area will experience minimal impacts during construction. West Morena and Morena Boulevards areas will need to be partially closed to traffic during construction. After completion, residents and businesses will experience improved reliability of the sewer collection systems.
