Overall Crime in 2010



- Overall crime was down 4.7% when comparing 2010 to 2009.
- The overall number of crimes was the lowest in 41 years.
- Crime rates in 2010 were the lowest since 1963.



Violent Crimes

- Four citizens out of 1,000 were victims of violent crimes.

- Robbery was down 14.1%
- Aggravated Assaults were down 0.4%



Property Crimes




- There were 30,753 property crimes in 2010 including burglary, theft and vehicle theft.




Crime Clearance Rates



- Just over half (51.3%) of violent crimes were cleared in 2010.
- Murder case clearance rate was 124.1%.
- Property crimes clearance rate was 12.5%.
- Total index clearance rate was 18.5%.

Domestic Violence, Gang, & Hate Crimes



- Total number of domestic violence cases decreased 7% in 2010.
- Gang crimes decreased 12.5%.
- Gang assaults and attempt homicides were down 21.2%.
- Hate crimes increased 4.3%.

Response Times



- Incoming calls are dispatched according to a five step hierarchy ranging from the highest priority (Priority E) to lowest priority (Priority 4).
- Response times for 2010 improved for priority 1, 2 and 3.
- Response times for priority E and 4 increased by 3.3% and 7.6% respectively.
- The number of dispatched calls by priority in 2010 decreased in all categories except priority E, which increased by 1.7%.
