# STAR/PAL History



- ▶ Initially two separate entities
  - San Diego PAL Chapter was founded in 1988 and primarily served county areas
  - STAR organization came into existence in 1993 to focus its programmatic efforts within city boundaries
- ▶ The two organizations merged in April of 1998, representing the alignment of city, county, and community efforts.
- ▶ The unification of programs, staff, volunteers, and the Board of Directors sought to ensure that all youth in the region have similar opportunities to participate and reap the benefits of youth programming with law enforcement officers, firefighters and community leaders.

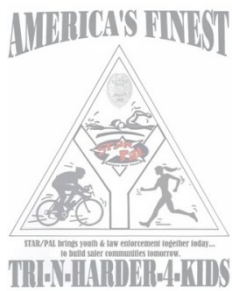
# 11<sup>th</sup> Annual Fundraiser

  - Join us for this fun-filled event on **Friday, April 22<sup>nd</sup>!**





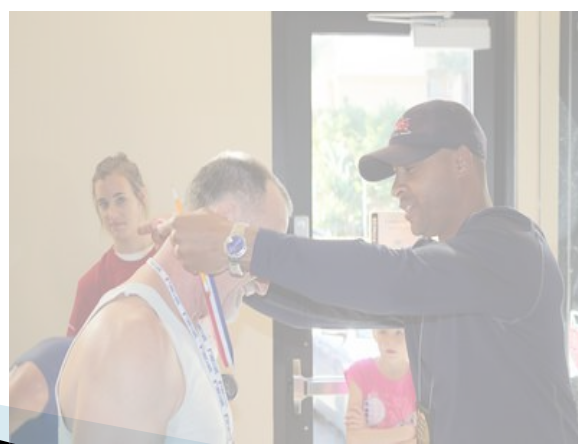
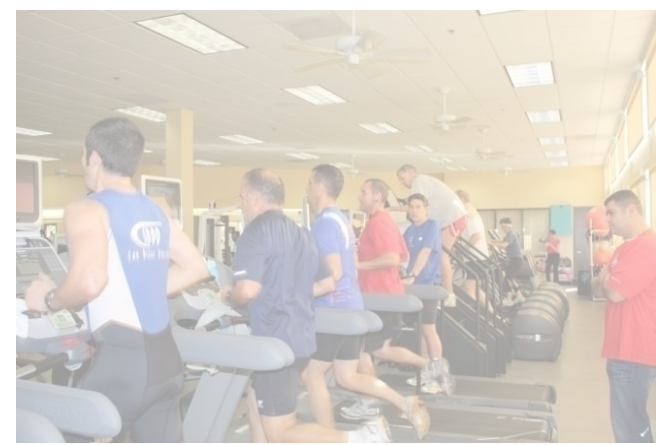
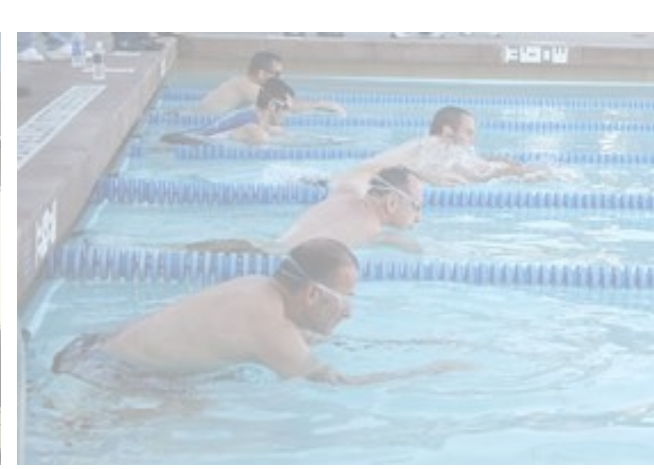


# New Fundraiser

- 23 Officers from SDPD & other local agencies "challenged" to put their athletic ability to the test...to "go the extra mile" for San Diego youth!
- Each tri participant raised at least \$300.
- Proceeds from event benefited STAR/PAL youth programs.
- Indoor triathlon: 10 minute pool swim, 20 minute cycle ride (stationary bike), & 15 minute treadmill run.
- Lawrence Family Jewish Community Center provided their facility as an event partner. Many other great sponsors!
- Raised over \$8,800 this year!

# STAR/PAL Awards



- ▶ **Senator Wadie P. Deddeh Community Service Award**
  - In January 2011, the Neighborhood Market Association awarded STAR/PAL for consistently given back to the community and for serving as a beacon of hope for those who need a helping hand or a push in the right direction.
- ▶ **Betty Peabody Award**
  - In May 2010, STAR/PAL received the San Diego Crime Stopper's Betty Peabody award, which is awarded to a civilian individual or organization that has helped law enforcement fight crime and promote public safety. Recipients of this award are recognized for the positive impact they have made on the quality of life in San Diego.

# STAR/PAL Awards



- ▶ **MetLife Foundation Community–Police Partnership Award**
  - October 2010 – STAR/PAL, the San Diego Police Dept., and the San Diego County Probation Dept. recognized by the Local Initiatives Support Corporation (LISC) & MetLife Foundation for having one of the most innovative and effective community safety alliances in the country.
  - STAR/PAL was selected from more than 700 applicants nationwide. This award recognizes partnerships between community organizations and police departments that have reduced crime and spurred positive development in low-income communities.
  - Will be used as national model. Published as case study.
