IRWM Program

- Statewide effort
- Involves water retailers, wastewater agencies, storm water and flood managers, watershed groups, the business community, tribes, agriculture, and non-profit stakeholders
- San Diego Region developed a IRWM plan in 2005

IRWM Program

San Diego IRWM

- The San Diego IRWM Program led by the San Diego Regional Water Management Group (RWMG)
- RWMG consists of the San Diego County Water Authority (CWA), the County and the City.
- Council adopted the San Diego IRWM plan in 2007

Prop 84 Grant Program

- Passed by California Voters in 2006
- Provides \$1 Billion for IRWM projects
- \$91 Million allocated to San Diego Region for implementation projects.
- Projects selected by IRWM participants
- Projects approved for funding by Cal. Department of Water Resources (DWR)

Bannock Avenue Streetscape Enhancement

- Intended to reduce pollutant loads discharged to Tecolote Creek and Mission Bay
- Diverts urban runoff to Bioretention and Treatment planters
- Includes porous pavement to reduce storm water flows
- Completed 60% design

Grant Request

- \$650,000 granted by DWR
- \$12,500 retained by SDCWA for grant management
- \$630,500 will be allocated to construction costs
- Matching funds have already been expended for design costs
