Local Government Partnership

- CPUC funds the Independently Owned Utilities to establish and implement Local Government Partnerships
- SDG&E and the City of San Diego have been Partners under the auspices of this program since 2006.





- Current LGP Contract continues through December 31, 2012
- The CPUC issued Decision 12-05-015 on May 10, 2012 to provide guidance on 2013-2014 Energy Efficiency Portfolios
- Two Year Extension for “Transition Period” to align funding with State goals



- City staff worked with SDG&E on the utility's submittal to the CPUC- due July 6, 2012.
- The CPUC is scheduled to provide final approval on November 29, 2012.
- If the final contract extension between SDG&E and the City is not completed by January 1, 2013, then there will be month-to month extensions until such time that the contract can be completed.



Key provisions of the City of San Diego's LGP include the following:

- Funding total is \$2,249,200
- Funding can be used for staff and consultants, but not for equipment, construction costs, or customer rebates
- The Environmental Services Department manages the LGP for the City and works collaboratively with other City departments



Programs to increase energy efficiency:

- Facility upgrades and retrofits
- Public Outreach and Education
- Review and Refine Codes and Standards
- Leveraging resources and expertise across City departments
- Leveraging resources and expertise in the region.
