Mission Bay Park (features)

- 4,600 acres of bay and park areas
- 27 miles of shoreline
- 6 resort hotels and 2 campgrounds
- 7 seasonal lifeguard protected swim areas
- Many camps, clubs and user groups



Mission Bay Park (Aquatics)

- Swimming, kayaking, canoeing, SUP's
- Wind surfing, kite boarding, sailing, fishing
- Personal Water Craft (PWC)
- Power boating, water skiing, wake boarding
- Commercial sport fishing and dive charters
- Whale watching



Mission Bay Park (On land)

- Picnic and barbeque facilities
- Play grounds, basket ball, volley ball
- Walking and running trails
- Off-leash dog park on Fiesta Island
- Remote control model airplane area
- Belmont Park, Sea World Park



Mission Bay Park (Services)

- ▶ 11 Marinas with more than 2,200 slips
- 5 public boat launch ramps
- 2 fuel docks
- ▶ 126 Moorings and 232 Beach Bar Permits
- Temporary docking & boat pump out facilities
- Permit-only water ski and PWC area
- Several recreation vessel rental operations



Mission Bay Park (Events)

- Many local, national and international events
 - Local running races and triathlons
 - Canoe and paddleboard races
 - San Diego Crew Classic
 - Thunderboat Regatta
 - Corporate events



Boating Safety Unit (BSU)

- Patrols Mission Bay and City Coastline
- Emergency services include:
 - Swimmer rescue
 - Boat rescue
 - Medical aid
 - Marine fire suppression
 - Sinking vessel pump out
 - Emergency boat tows
 - Law enforcement (Peace Officers)





Boating Safety Unit (BSU)

- Lifeguard Communication Center (LCC)
 - 911 Public Safety Answering Point
 - Emergency radio dispatching
 - Emergency VHF Marine Radio monitoring
 - California Law Enforcement Telecommunication System (CLETS computer terminal access)
 - 24/7 surveillance of Mission Bay entrance

BSU Boating Law Enforcement

- Boating accident prevention measures
 - Boating Citations (top three categories)
 - Vessel speed violations
 - Vessel carriage requirements and registration
 - Water skiing violations
 - Preventative Acts
 - Warnings
 - Public education




