Proposed Ballot Measure-Charter Sec 77 delete "all proceeds received from the sale of city owned real property".....

Proceeds from sales of real estate are now restricted to be spent on capital projects.

Why should the general fund be excluded from the use of this money?

Why shouldnt the city council decide what is the best use of the money,?

Should an old outdated charter provision take precedence over the general fund deficit ?

For example Capital expenditure is not automatically more important than our fire-rescue dept, which has the job of saving peoples lives.

The recommended amendment would not exclude capital expenditures; it would give the city council the power to decide where the need is greatest.
