

### Tree Service Contracts Bid #10023410-13-Q

- Action is to request approval to award three tree service contracts that will exceed \$1 million in total cost over five-year period (initial one-year term plus four one-year options to renew):
  - Atlas Environmental
  - Aztec Landscaping
  - West Coast Arborists
- Contracts result from a shared solicitation of tree services across multiple departments



- Consolidation of all tree service contract work was desired by Purchasing and Contracting to achieve economies of scale and reduce costs
- Comparison of proposed tree service contracts and existing/expiring tree service contracts results in an estimated cost savings to be as much as 43% per labor hour on average
- Solicitation for tree services began March 2012 and ended July 2012
- Award proposed in eight sections

- Purchasing Process:
  - Contracts competitively bid per Municipal Code §22.3001
  - Lowest responsive bid in each section recommended for award
  - Vendor required to pay living wage per Municipal Code §22.4201
  - Contract pricing may change annually
    - Living wage rate adjusts each year based on CPI
    - · Inflation adjustment
    - · Amount not to exceed 5% annually



#### Purchasing Process:

- Contract term is up to five years total: initial one-year term plus up to four one-year options to renew
- Contracts are phase funded FY 2013 to FY 2018
- Contracts have not yet been awarded as at least one will exceed \$1 million in the initial contract term; the other contracts will exceed \$1 million in cumulative expenditures in one of the option years
- Municipal Code §22.3211(d) requires Council approval for contracts exceeding this threshold

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
