





# Scope

- **Restore 14 acres**
  - 11.3 acres of uplands
  - 2.9 acres of wetlands
- **Trail improvements**
  - Refurbish 4 miles of trails
    - Close unapproved trails
    - Install stairs, puncheon bridges, switchbacks, retaining walls
    - Install Signage: trailhead signs, access point signs and trail markers

# Fiscal Considerations

- Maintenance of Grant Improvements required for 20 years.
- City to assume maintenance following restoration success criteria met and installation of trail improvements.
- SDCL to provide support for maintenance of restoration and trail improvements.
- \$20,000 maintenance fund to City by SDCL for trail and signage maintenance/replacement.
- City responsible for improvements when/if SDCL unable to perform and, if desired, beyond 20 years.




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**Project Components**

- Project Canyon (Bolster Existing Volunteer Stewardship Programs)
- Project Habitat Restoration Area (14 Acres Minimum)
- Next CEP Target Area (2013)
- Trailheads
- Project Canyon Trail Planned for Refurbishment (4 miles, with Signage)
- Potential "Canyon Corridor" (Integrate with City's Urban Greening Planning Grant)
- Existing Park Footpath
- Parks
- Schools
