Background

- On October 17, 2011, City authorized the Agreement with Sprint Solutions, Inc. (Sprint), to provide the City wireless goods and services
- On October 28, 2013, City Council authorized an Amendment to the Agreement with Sprint



Status of Current Deliverables

- 1. 98% coverage within the City of San Diego
- 2. 95% coverage extending 20 miles North and East of the City



Status of Issues

- SDPD Connectivity with Sprint Wireless System
 - On January 21, 2014, SDPD entered into a contract with Verizon Wireless
 - Verizon coverage is meeting Police Department's operational needs
- SDFD Connectivity with Sprint Wireless System
 - Sprint is meeting Fire Department operational needs



Status of Issues cont'd

- Other Departments Connectivity with Sprint Wireless System
 - Transportation & Storm Water
 - -Continues to report connectivity issues at the Chollas Operations Yard
 - Department will be evaluating sole source option pending completion of Tower Upgrades
 - Environmental Services
 - Continues to report connectivity issues at the Chollas Operations Yard
 - -Department will be evaluating sole source option pending completion of Tower Upgrades



Status of Issues cont'd

- Public Works Engineering & Capital Projects Field Survey Crews
 -Received poor coverage in remote areas
 - -Department has been granted a sole source to use an alternate vendor
- City Attorney's Office
 - Poor coverage within the Civic Center Plaza building

Recommendations

- Continue with the current month-to-month one-year extension to the Agreement with Sprint
- Continue the current practice of allowing departments to utilize alternate vendors
- Return to Committee in May with options for providing the City's wireless services when the current extension expires in October. Options include:
 - Issue a new RFP for citywide wireless services
 - Leverage Western States Contract Alliance (WSCA) Wireless Communication & Equipment contracts
 - Execute the second one-year option with Sprint
