I am submitting a ballot proposal to objectively and independently set the salary for Council and the Mayor. My proposal would save considerable staff costs and be completely objective and independent of political manipulation and conflicts of interest.

My ballot proposal would be a PROPOSAL TO MODIFY PROCEDURE FOR SETTING SALARIES OF COUNCIL AND MAYOR

1. Strike:
Charter Sections 41.1, 12.1 and 24.1 which establish a procedures for

setting the salary for council and mayor.

2. Replace With it with a new system in the charter:

A system that precludes the City Council from any input or vote on Council or Mayor salaries. Create a mechanism for establishing salaries, and raising them, tied to a reasonable indicator, perhaps similar to the current system in use at the County of San Diego [The specific language to achieve this objective to be recommended by the City Attorney or other designee of Council]

Please inform me of any further steps I must take to assist your consideration of this matter. I request notice of any hearings concerning ballot proposals and copies of any reports or communications issued concerning these matters.
