

How It Works?

Arrested For Drunk in Public – 647 (f) PC

Transported to Sobering Center

Rejected on 6th Visit – 30 days

Booked Into Jail

Offered SIP at Arraignment

Assessed by MHS Inc. Case Manager

Transported to Program



Emergency Response Access Program (ERAP) City of San Diego EMS/Paramedic Abusers

Chronic Alcoholics

12 Individuals Transported 316 times

Cost \$469,843



1 year – 52 runs 8 arrests
\$85,000

Assigned an “On Call” Officer

Partnership with ERAP Coordinator

Coordinated with Patrol Officers
