EXECUTIVE SUMMARY OF ITEM BACKGROUND:

The mission of the Internet Crimes Against Children Task Force (ICAC) is to develop a multi-jurisdictional task force comprised of Local, State, and Federal Law Enforcement Agencies and Prosecutors. ICAC works to identify, target, apprehend and prosecute sexual predators whose purpose is to exploit children or engage in illicit sexual activity with children through the use of computers and the Internet. ICAC conducts both proactive and reactive investigations targeting sexual predators using the Internet to entice and lure children for sexual activity. ICAC actively participates in community education efforts to promote Internet safety and security measures and prevent Internet crimes against children. Additionally, ICAC offers support and technical training opportunities in a collaborative effort with countywide agencies to promote partnerships and community policing efforts.

- Notification from NCMEC identified CP on a Facebook users acct
- Military suspect who had been stationed in several states
- Two victims identified/grooming
- Evidence seized from Japan/extradited
- 18 year sentence, sex registrant status
- 32 Videos, 1619 images

- Send images and videos
