Consideration of proposed changes to San Diego Municipal Code section 66.0127 – Refuse Collection ‘The People’s Ordinance’ and related sections.

Since the People's Ordinance only applies to single family homeowners which is about half the households in the city of San Diego, the League of Women Voters of San Diego is recommending a re-vote. The People's Ordinance was originally adopted in 1919 and amended in 1986 by a vote of the people. It requires the City to collect residential refuse from a public street at least once a week for no City fee.
