SUBJECT: Correction for the Smart Growth & Land Use Committee (SG&LU) of July 27, 2016 Minutes

This memorandum is to serve as a correction to the record for the Update on the City's Car Share and Bike Share Programs, Item 3.

During the item, Councilmember Sherman had asked the length of the term of the Deco Bike contract. I provided the response that it was five (5) years, and there is an option for 5 additional years. For the record, I misspoke and the agreement is for a 10 year term, not 5 years as stated in the Smart Growth and Land Use Committee meeting on July 27, 2016.

The specific contract language is as follows:

*3.1 Term: This Agreement shall commence on the Effective Date and shall end ten (10) years from the date of Operational Rollout for the first phase of implementation (Phase I Operational Rollout).*

*3.4 Renewal: The Parties may renew this Agreement on the same terms and conditions specified in this Agreement for up to two (2) additional five (5) year terms. Any such renewal shall be in writing executed by the Parties.*
