RESOLUTION:

* ITEM-S402: Two-Way Operation on South 45th Street.

(Southeastern San Diego Community Area. District-4.)

CITY MANAGER'S RECOMMENDATION:

Adopt the following resolution:

(R-2003-703)

Converting 45th Street from a one-way northbound operation to a two-way operation between Boston Avenue and Logan Avenue;

Authorizing the installation of the necessary signs and markings; declaring that the regulations imposed shall become effective upon the installation of the signs.

CITY MANAGER SUPPORTING INFORMATION:

This action converts South 45th Street from one-way northbound operation to a two-way operation between Boston Avenue and Logan Avenue. In 1987, the City Council adopted a resolution to convert the street from two-way operation to one-way northbound operation. Conversion back to two-way operation requires Council approval, according to San Diego Municipal Code section 82.19. Either one-way operation or two-way operation are acceptable for traffic purposes; accordingly, Traffic Engineering Division does not oppose either alternative. A petition signed by 13 of 19 affected properties (representing 76% of the abutting property) was submitted supporting this action. A subsequent petition signed by 6 of 19 affected properties (representing 19% of abutting property) was submitted in opposition to this action. The Southeastern San Diego Development Committee does not support this action.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Fiscal Impact is minimal. Funds are budgeted within the Transportation Department, Street Division's, operating fund for this purpose
