STAFF RECOMMENDATION:

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

The Metropolitan Wastewater Department (MWWD) is requesting authorization to advertise, bid, and award a contract to the lowest responsible bidder, for the Pipeline Rehabilitation Project Phase D-1. This contract is the fourth in a series of MWWD contracts to meet the EPA requirements to rehabilitate sewer pipelines.

MWWD has inspected and assessed aging sewer mains under a separate Closed Circuit Televising (CCTV) contract and identified the need to rehabilitate a large amount of deteriorated sewer mains. This project will rehabilitate approximately 10 miles of this pipe ranging in size from 6-inch to 12-inch diameter. Predominantly the pipeline rehabilitation will be accomplished by installing liners inside the pipes using trenchless construction methods. All service lateral connections will be sealed between a liner and a host pipe. Approximately 100 manholes will be rehabilitated, some of which will require surface excavation. Approximately 28 end-of-line clean-outs will be installed to allow liner installation of sewer mains that currently have plugged ends. All work will be located within existing City right-of-way and easements. Work will be accomplished in various locations throughout the city.

This contract will help meet EPA requirements to reduce sewer spills while reducing maintenance costs and extending the service life of aging sewer mains. The use of trenchless technology is faster, less expensive, and less disruptive to the community than the traditional excavation and replacement method.

FISCAL CONSIDERATIONS:

The total cost of this action is \$5,670,219 and will be funded from Fund 41506, CIP 46-050.0, Annual Allocation - Pipeline Rehabilitation, Phase D-1 project, contingent upon the approval of the Fiscal Year 2008 Capital Improvement Program and Appropriation Ordinance. The project costs may be bond reimbursed up to 80% by future short term or long term debt financings anticipated in May, 2007 or April, 2008. An Auditor's Certificate will be issued prior to contract award.



Description of Activity: Sewer Pipeline Rehabilitation Project "Phase D-1": The project proposes to rehabilitate approximately 10.0 miles of existing sewer pipelines, located on multiple streets and sewer easements within numerous Community Planning Areas. The majority of pipeline segments to be rehabilitated are located within the street right-of-way. Segments which are located outside of the right-of-way would be accessed via manholes in rights-of-way or accessed via manholes outside of the right-of-way in non-sensitive areas (i.e. ornamentally landscaped property, existing trails and access paths). All segments would be rehabilitated by utilizing "slip-lining" technology.

Two methods of slip lining may be used for this project, both utilizing existing manholes and/or potential cleanouts. Both require access to two manholes for each pipe segment. Cured in place pipe (CIPP) liner is pulled through the sewer main, cured using hot water or steam, and cut at both manholes. Ribloc (spiral) liner is pulled through the sewer main as plastic strips and then formed to the pipe to create one within the existing pipe.

Where a sewer segment lacks one of the required manholes, a cleanout shall be installed. Twenty-six cleanouts are proposed for installation and will occur only within non-sensitive areas. The installation of cleanouts involves excavating a five-foot wide by five-foot long area from the ground surface to the existing pipeline, within existing pipeline trenches and previously disturbed soil.

Internal and/or external point repairs may occur in portions of pipe that require repair (i.e. due to offset joints, sags, or intruding laterals). Internal point repairs involve similar methods as the rehabilitation and are contained solely within the pipe. External point repairs involve excavation of an area five feet wide from the ground surface to the existing pipeline. The length of excavation depends on the length of the segment in need of repair. Excavation of the area would occur within the existing pipeline trenches and previously disturbed soil. No disturbance of native soils is proposed. No trenching would occur outside previously disturbed soils. No disturbance to native vegetation is proposed.

Location of Activity: The work will be located on multiple streets and sewer easements City-wide in San Diego, California. Please see attached table for location details.



That the expenditure of an amount not to exceed \$5,670,219 from Sewer Fund No. 41506, CIP 46-050.0, Annual Allocation - Pipeline Rehabilitation, is authorized, solely and exclusively to provide funds for construction of the above project and related costs, contingent on City Council approval of the project's inclusion in the Fiscal Year 2008 Capital Improvement Program budget and Appropriation Ordinance; and provided that the City Auditor and Comptroller furnishes one or more certificates demonstrating that the funds necessary for this expenditure are, or will be, on deposit in the City treasury.

4. That the City Auditor and Comptroller is authorized to transfer excess budgeted funds, if any, to the appropriate reserves on advice from the administering department.

5. That the above activity is categorically exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act pursuant to CEQA Guidelines section 15301(b), as the repair and maintenance of existing sewer facilities.
