STAFF RECOMMENDATION:

1. Approve the extension of the existing agreement to provide hazardous materials response to members of the Joint Powers Agreement (JPA) from July 1, 2007 through June 30, 2009.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

The Hazardous Materials Incident Response Team (HIRT) was established by a JPA by the San Diego County Unified Disaster Council (UDC) in 1986. The San Diego Fire-Rescue Department participates in this program by providing hazardous materials emergency response using HIRT to agencies that are members of the JPA. An agreement between the City of San Diego and the Unified Disaster Council was originally signed in June, 1993, and amended in 1995, 1997, 1999, 2003 and 2005. The San Diego Fire-Rescue and the Unified Disaster Council propose an amendment to the existing agreement, Resolution #300403, adopted on May 9, 2005, which expires June 30, 2007. This proposed amendment extends the contract from July 1, 2007 through June 30, 2009 and adjusts the annual payment to the City of San Diego from \$765,902 to \$838,848.

FISCAL CONSIDERATIONS:

The Unified Disaster Council through the San Diego County Office of Emergency Services (OES) will provide the City of San Diego with annual payments of \$838,848, to be invoiced in quarterly increments. Payment will be applied to the Fire-Rescue General Fund Revenue Account #77353. There is no other fiscal impact to the General Fund as the HIRT is already budgeted.

PREVIOUS COUNCIL and/or COMMITTEE ACTION:

The City Council approved all previous agreement extensions as noted above.


COMMUNITY PARTICIPATION AND PUBLIC OUTREACH EFFORTS:

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO AMEND AN AGREEMENT WITH THE SAN DIEGO COUNTY UNIFIED DISASTER COUNCIL TO CONTINUE SAN DIEGO FIRE-RESCUE DEPARTMENT PARTICIPATION IN THE HAZARDOUS MATERIALS INCIDENT RESPONSE TEAM FROM JULY 1, 2007 THROUGH JUNE 30, 2009.

WHEREAS, the Hazardous Materials Incident Response Team [HIRT] was established by a Joint Powers Agreement [JPA] by the San Diego County Unified Disaster Council [UDC] in 1986; and

WHEREAS, the San Diego Fire-Rescue Department [SDFR] participates in this program by providing hazardous materials emergency response using HIRT to agencies that are members of the JPA; and

WHEREAS, an agreement between the City of San Diego and the Unified Disaster Council [UDC] was originally signed in June 1993, extended by amendment in 1995, 1997, 1999, 2003, and 2005, all previously approved by Council; and

WHEREAS, the SDFR and the UDC now propose an amendment to the existing agreement, (Resolution No. R-300403, adopted on May 9, 2005), which is set to expire on June 30, 2007; and

WHEREAS, this proposed amendment extends the existing agreement from July 1, 2007 through June 30, 2009, and further adjusts the annual payment to the City of San Diego from \$765,902 to \$838, 848; and

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WHEREAS, upon this amendment the UDC, through the San Diego County Office of Emergency Services [OES], will provide the City of San Diego with annual payments of \$838,848, to be invoiced in quarterly increments; and

WHEREAS, these payment will be applied to the Fire-Rescue General Fund Revenue Account No. 77353; and

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, that the Mayor is hereby authorized and empowered to amend the agreement with the San Diego Unified Disaster Council to continue San Diego Fire-Rescue Department participation in the Hazardous Materials Incident Response Team from July 1, 2007 through June 30, 2009; as more particularly described in the agreement on file in the City Clerk's Office as Document No. RR-300403.
