WHEREAS, for the first twenty-three years of Jan Garbosky's career in San Diego City Schools [SDCS], all of her positions were part of the district's Integrations Programs, focused on ensuring racial, ethnic and gender equality; and

WHEREAS, since 1989, Jan Garbosky has been working to make schools safe for lesbian, gay, bisexual and transgender [LGBT] students, parents and staff; and

WHEREAS, Jan Garbosky organized the "First Thursday" meetings, which was the first support group for LGBT educators; and

WHEREAS, Jan Garbosky coordinated the SDCCD Superintendent's Committee on LGBT issues in education; and

WHEREAS, Jan Garbosky developed and presented to staff at over one-hundred schools and district departments SDCCS' "Training on Non-Discrimination Based on Sexual Orientation;" and

WHEREAS, Jan Garbosky founded and co-chaired the San Diego Chapter of the Gay, Lesbian and Straight Education Network [GLSEN]; and

WHEREAS, Jan Garbosky supported the filming of "It's Elementary: Talking About Gay Issues in School;" and

WHEREAS, Jan Garbosky has presented on gay and lesbian issues in education at local, state and national conferences and organizations; and


