WHEREAS, Maurice Eis is a prominent and significant part of the Rancho Bernardo community, and has dedicated countless hours contributing to the well being of residents by serving as a diligent and devoted volunteer; and

WHEREAS, Maurice was born in Frankfurt, Germany, survived encampment in Dachau Concentration Camp in 1938, and went on to serve in the U.S. Army in World War II, where he earned numerous service medals, as well as a special commendation from France; and

WHEREAS, after World War II, Maurice served as a language interpreter for the U.S. Army, and continues to show his patriotism by staying actively involved with the Veteran's Hospital and the Veterans of Foreign Wars; and

WHEREAS, Maurice generously committed over 3,500 hours to the Rancho Bernardo RSVP, doing vacation house checks and You Are Not Alone calls, and acting as Block Captain for his local Neighborhood Watch Program; and

WHEREAS, Maurice's work with Meals on Wheels and the North County Council on Aging strives to improve the quality of life for the seniors of our community; and

WHEREAS, Maurice has been awarded multiple accolades from the community, including the Dr. Edgar Lutz award, the Veteran of the Year award, and the honor of serving as the Parade Marshal for the Rancho Bernardo Spirit of the Fourth Parade, in addition to being interviewed as a Holocaust survivor for Stephen Spielberg's "Shoal" program; and


